The basic science curriculum of full year courses consists of:
BIOLOGY, PHYSICAL SCIENCE, CHEMISTRY, ANATOMY and PHYSIOLOGY, and PHYSICS.
More comprehensive studies in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics are also offered as full year courses:

ADVANCED CHEMISTRY, ADVANCED BIOLOGY, and ADVANCED PHYSICS.
In addition, the Science Department offers semester courses in the following areas:
