



Too late to achieve our ideals.












While we still can, we must learn from others, live with others.

you'll wish you were eighteen again.


























Class President's Message








Science



It is our hope that students will select courses carefully and participate fully in the activities of each class.






























Foreign Language




Mathematics

Business



In the high school library students will find books, periodicals, and audio-visuals selected to supplement their courses. In addition, a large collection of paperbacks for leisure reading is available.














Guidance


Our main goal is to guide the students in examining their abilities, capabilities, interests, attitudes, habits, and volitions.



Offerings include Independent Living, Family and Society, Exploring Parenthood, and Interior Design, as well as courses in the areas of food and clothing.


