In a few days we will be graduated and we will leave M. H. S., but we will always remember the fine times we have had here and know they will prove to be some of the best days of our lives.



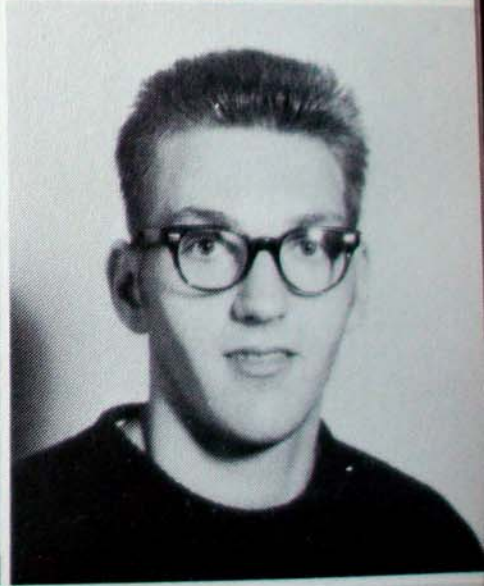
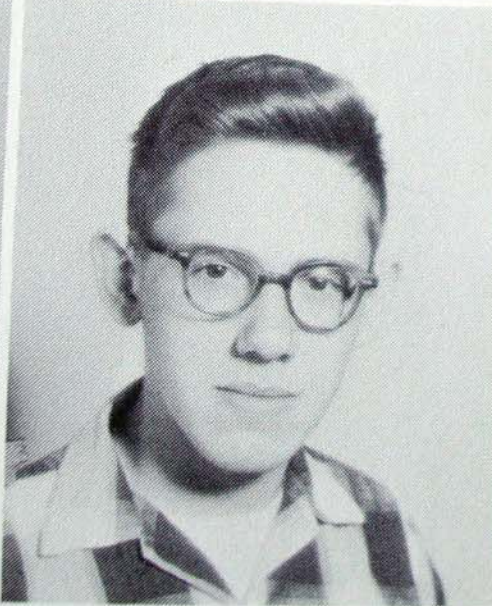
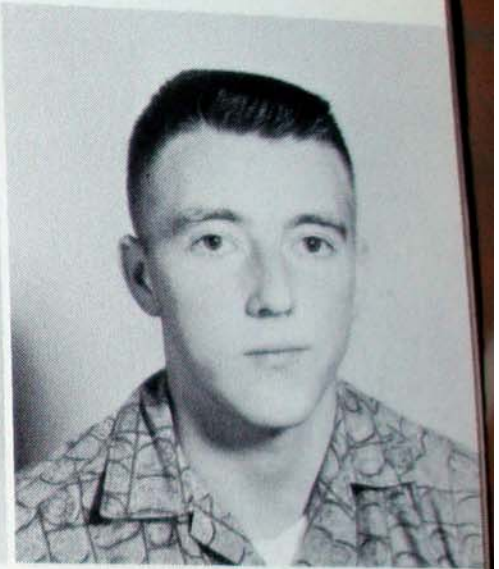
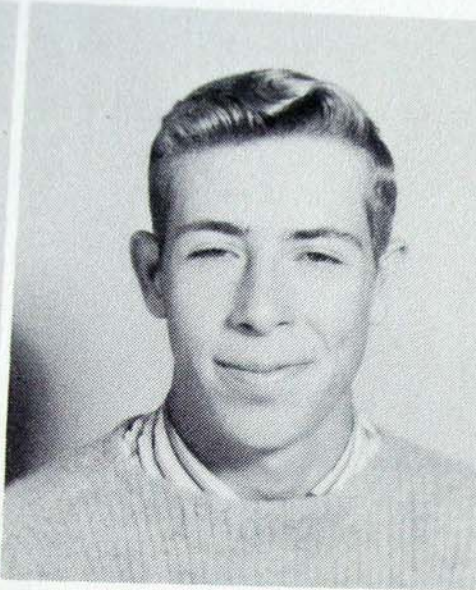
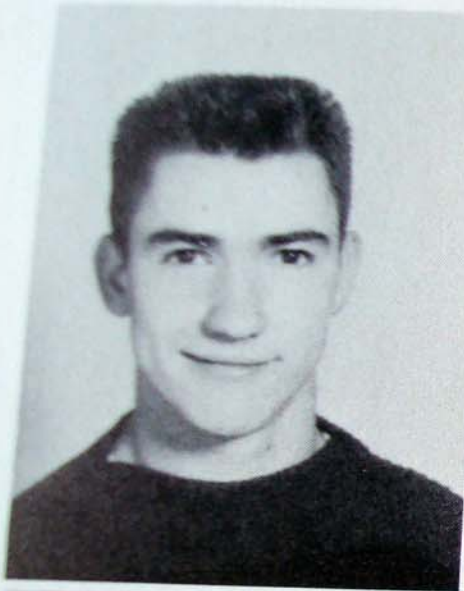
