8 And they with whom precious stones were found, gaue them to the treasure of the house of the LORD, by the hand of Jehiel the Gerlhonite.

9 Then the people reioyced, to, that they offeed willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LOBD: and David the King allo reioyced with greatioy.
