Ramadan is a very special time for Muslims all over the world. Observing Ramadan is very important for all Muslims. During Ramadan, all Muslims over the age of 12, with some exceptions, are expected to fast between dawn and sunset.

During Ramadan, the day starts early so that people can eat a pre-fast meal before dawn. This meal, called Suhoor, is important as it will keep them going through the day. Ancient Egyptians' children also played with toys, and many of their games are still enjoyed by young people in the present day.
