at every season's end

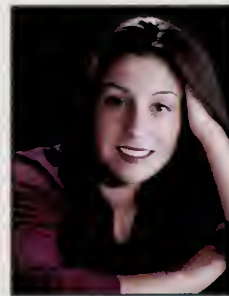

Special thanks to all the advisors who make the club possible and all the students who participated this year.





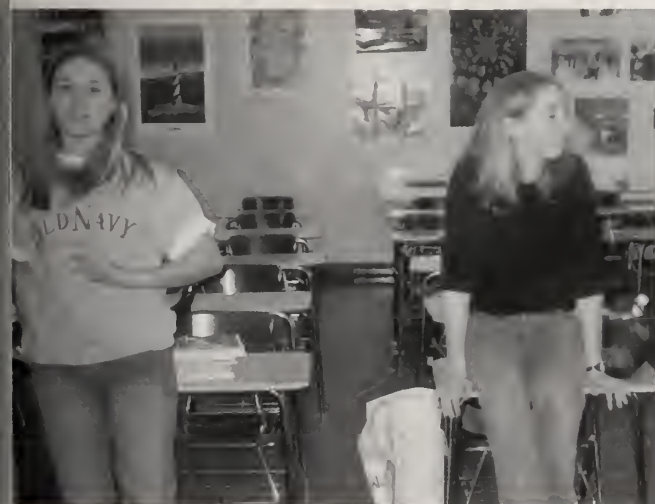

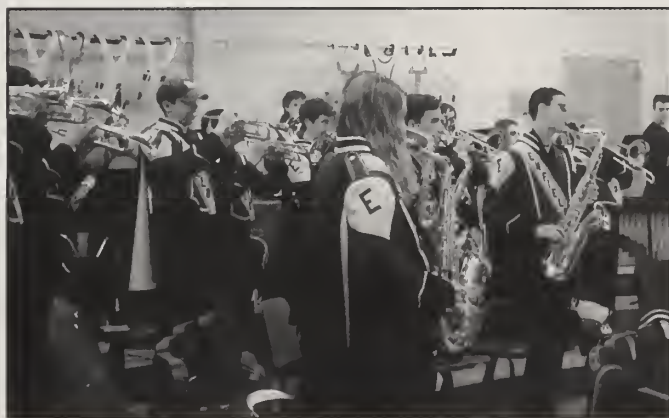




Band

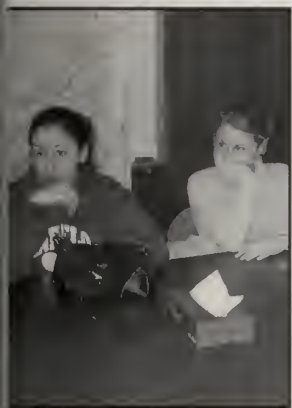
Unified Sports
