




NKJ Romans 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.



NAU Romans 10:17

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.



NRS Romans 10:17

So faith comes from what is heard, and what is heard comes through the word of Christ.



ESV Romans 10:17

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.



NIV Romans 10:17

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.



NJB Romans 10:17

But it is in that way faith comes, from hearing, and that means hearing the word of Christ.



NLT Romans 10:17

Yet faith comes from listening to this message of good news— the Good News about Christ.



MSG Romans 10:17

The point is, Before you trust, you have to listen. But unless Christ's Word is preached, there's nothing to listen to.

NJB John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word: the Word was with God and the Word was God.

NKJ John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

NLT John 1:1 In the beginning the Word already existed. He was with God, and he was God.

NWT John 1:1 In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was a god.

KJV Genesis 4:1 And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD.

NIV Genesis 4:1 Adam lay with his wife Eve, and she became pregnant and gave birth to Cain. She said, "With the help of the LORD I have brought forth a man."

NIV Philippians 3:8
