SUMMARY

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) has initiated a feasibility study for a Vermont Bus Rapid Transit Corridor that is evaluating transit alternatives along a 12.5-mile north-south corridor extending from Hollywood Boulevard to 120th Street in the City and County of Los Angeles.

Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) offers improved bus service that provides:

- Faster, more reliable and convenient service
- Dedicated bus lanes
- Signal priority
- Other features

As a community stakeholder, your feedback is important to our planning efforts. 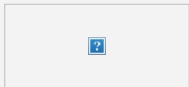
