As an organization that represents businesses in the Los Angeles area, you play a critical role in equipping businesses to succeed. The City of Los Angeles would like to introduce you to some important changes to minimum wage requirements that will take effect on July 1, 2016 for businesses operating in Los Angeles. The City of Los Angeles will require a minimum wage of \$10.50 for businesses and employees that meet the eligibility criteria. Paid sick time requirements are currently in the process of moving through the City Council and may also be effective as early as July 1, 2016.
