It was great to talk to you this evening and catch up a bit. We are working on renewing the BLQ-Pico BID; you helped us with that project 3 1/2 years ago by coordinating our Korean out-reach for the Petitions. We'd love to ask you to do that for us again. We have about 24% Korean property owners (my estimate) totaling about 13.6% of the assessment and no way to talk with them effectively. My estimate of the number of hours would be about 10 hrs / wk for 8 wks = 80 hrs. Our Petitions need to be complete by the end of April.
