#### On the Final Results of the 31 October 2020 Parliamentary Elections of Georgia

Tbilisi

December 3, 2020

During the session on December 3, 2020, the Central Election Commission of Georgia summed up the final results of the 31 October 2020 Parliamentary Elections of Georgia, according to the subparagraph “K” of paragraph 1 of the Article 14, paragraph 4 of the Article 30, the Article 70, paragraph 3 of the Article 76, paragraph 5 of the Article 77 and paragraphs 13 and 16 of the Article 196, of the Organic Law of Georgia “Election Code of Georgia”, “Summary Protocol on the Results of the 31 October 2020 Parliamentary Elections of Georgia Held through the Proportional Contest”, and “Summary Protocol on the Results of the First Round of the 31 October 2020 Parliamentary Elections of Georgia Held through the Majoritarian Contest”, drawn up by the Central Election Commission of Georgia on November 13, 2020 and determined:
