Africa. The Aswan Botanical Garden offers a beautiful escape from the city. It's on Kitchener's Island, to the west of Elephantine Island. It's one of two islands in the Nile to the city-centre of Aswan Egypt. The Aswan Botanical Island is divided

into 27 squares which look like a chess board. A number of rare palm trees can be found there on the Island.

The only way to reach the Aswan Botanical Garden is by boat, either on one of the public ferries or by felucca tour while sightseeing this beautiful part of the Nile River. The Kitchener's island has three entrances. The main entrance of the Island is on the northern end of the island. The best way to see the whole island, without having to walk a lot, is to enter the main entrance and walk the full length of the island until you reach the southern end; book a felucca from there and ask the captain to wait for you at the other end.
