It is better for carrying goods over short distances. Railways were developed in the 19th century. They have the ability to transport heavy goods; it is also very cheap, safe, and also comfortable for passengers over a long distance. Water transport is the cheapest way of transporting heavy goods over a long distance. There are two major types of water transport: Inland





water transport (rivers, lakes, and man-made canals) and ocean water transport which carries a lot of the world's heavy goods and passengers from one country to another at the cheapest cost. 

9th September 2021, Mahmoud Al-Araby *passed away* on Thursday at the age of 89. He was born in 1932 in Ashmoun, Menoufia. Mahmoud's father died when he was young. He then moved to live in Cairo and worked as a salesman in a small shop. He turned to become the co-founder of one of the largest business in Egypt, Al-Araby Group, in 1964. He also owned many agencies in Egypt, including Sharp, Toshiba, SICO and others. He became a great Egyptian businessperson.
