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Teaching Tips

To teach is to touch lives forever. (Proverb) تم تقسيم الوحدات إلى خطوات لتساعدك على تقديم الدروس بطريقة سهلة

Conversation Time

- Clarify the meaning of new words or phrases in the conversation through drawings, actions or pictures.
 پهمکنك توضیح معانی المفردات الجدیدة من خلال الرسم أو الحركة أو الصور.
- Model the conversation in such a way that students can see it presented in a natural way.
 قم بتمثیل المحادثة لکی یراك التلامیذ وأنت تقدمها بطریقة طبیعیة.
- Bring students (one student for each speaker in the conversation) to the front of the classroom and have them face each other.
 - قم بإحضار التلاميذ لمقدمة الفصل (تلميذ لدور كل متحدث)، واجعلهم يقفون أمام بعضهم.
- Stand behind each student and model his/her line(s) of the conversation, using natural facial expressions and body language.
 - يمكنك الوقوف وراء كل واحد منهم والقيام بدوره بقراءة السطر الخاص بالشخصية مستخدمًا تعبيرات الوجه ولغة الجسد.
- In this way, students know who says which line of the conversation.
 - بهذه الطريقة يعرف التلاميذ من قائل كل سطر في المحادثة.
- Divide the class into groups (one group for each speaker in the conversation). Model each line of the conversation again.
 - قسم الفصل إلى مجموعات (مجموعة لدور كل متحدث)، وقم بقراءة كل سطر بالتمثيل مرة أخرى.
- Group (A) repeats the first line of the conversation, Group (B) repeats the second line of the conversation and so on.
 - المجموعة الأولى تكرر السطر الأول (الدور الأول) في المحادثة، والمجموعة الثانية تكرر السطر الثاني (الدور الثاني) وهكذا.
- Groups then change roles and repeat the conversation until each group has practised each role.
 تتبادل المجموعات الأدوار إلى أن تقوم كل مجموعة بالتدريب على كل دور.
- Students are now ready to say the conversation on their own.

- Introduce each vocabulary item in such a way that students hear and understand its meaning.
 قم بتقديم المفردات بطريقة تجعل تلاميذك يسمعون ويفهمون المعنى.
- Hold up and name each Word Time Picture Card one by one.
 أمسك ببطاقات مقدم عليها المفردات الجديدة مصورة (كل كلمة في بطاقة) واقرأها بصوت مسموع.
- While students listen, hold up and name the cards again and have students repeat.
 قم يامساك البطاقات مرة أخرى، واطلب إلى تلاميذك ترديد ما يسمعونه.

Word Time

هناك بعض الطرق لتعليم المفردات الجديدة وخاصة الصعبة منها مثل:

Back-chaining:

التسلسل العكسي:

Backward buildup: is a technique used in teaching oral language skills, especially with difficult words. وخاصة مع الكلمات الصعبة.

- The teacher pronounces the last syllable, the student repeats and then the teacher continues, working backwards from the end of the word to the beginning.
 - ينطق المدرس آخر مقطع في الكلمة ويردد وراءه التلاميذ، ثم يكمل مبتدئًا من نهاية الكلمة إلى بدايتها، مقسمًا إياها إلى مقاطع.





For example:

- To teach the word "entertainment", a teacher will pronounce the last syllable: (ment) and have the students repeat it.
- Then the teacher will repeat it with (-tain-) attached before: (-tain-ment) after which all that remains is the first syllable: (enter-tain-ment)
- Back-chaining makes natural <u>stress</u> easier for the student. It is easier than the front-chaining, which starts from the first syllable because back-chaining requires that the student put the new element first where it is more <u>difficult to forget</u>.

• التسلسل العكسى يسهل على التلميذ تعلم الكلمات الصعبة بطريقة أسهل من التسلسل الأمامي الذي يبدأ من أول مقطع، حيث يبدأ التسلسل العكسي بالجزء الجديد فيصعب نسيانه.

- Back-chaining can also be applied to whole sentences, for instance when teachers model dialogue sentences for learners to imitate.
- أيضًا يمكن استخدام التسلسل العكسي مع الجمل -مثلًا- عندما يريد المدرس أن يدرب تلاميذه على جمل المحادثات حيث يقلّده التلاميذ.
- The teacher first models the whole sentence. When they get faulty and hesitant imitation responses from the students.

• يبدأ المدرس بعمل نموذج لقراءة الجملة كاملة عندما يستشعر الخطأ والتردد في الاستجابة للتقليد.

Here is an example:

- Teacher: I'll give him your message. (Students find it difficult to reproduce the sentence.)
- · Teacher: message.
- · Student: message.
- · Teacher: Your message. (Students imitate.)
- Teacher: I'll give him your message. (Students imitate the whole sentence correctly.)
- The more students see, hear, read, or write specific words, the better they learn these words.

Focus Time / Practice Time

- Introduce the target patterns in a step-by-step way. Till students are familiar with the patterns.
 - قم بتقديم أشكال القواعد بطريقة تربوية منظمة (خطوة بخطوة).
- Timelines are used as keys to show how the language refers to, and describes, time and events. خطوط الزمن «الوقت» تستخدم كمفاتيح لبيان كيفية استخدام اللغة في وصف الوقت والأحداث.
- They are diagrams that illustrate how a particular language item (often a verb in a particular tense) places particular events or situations in time and in relation to other events.
- فهي توضح كيف أن جزءًا معينًا من اللغة (غالبًا الفعل في زمن معين) يضع أحداثًا معينة أو مواقف في زمن محدد وعلاقته بالأحداث الأخرى.

Timelines are used to:


· Help students with a visual learning style.

- This line is usually marked with a point that represents now. Thus, the timeline is divided into the past and the future.

- A reading passage, related to the unit's topic, is provided.

- If you choose to teach the new words before students read the passage, write the new words in a column on the board.

- · Then point to and read each word before explaining its meaning.
