



He could not but confess surprise at the American push, enterprise and business sagacity in many of the European cities. Merchants are on the outlook for any new methods or ideas that are distinctly American and are not slow in adopting them. The Europeans, especially the Continental ones, seem to have realized that American methods and business-bringing ways are worthy of imitation.


