## PARKER JACK-KNIFE SAFETY FOUNTAIN PENS

The phenomenal record for sales which our Jack Knife Safety Fountain Pen has enjoyed ever since its introduction, a comparatively short time ago shows that it fills a long felt need. This is the first real Safety Pen that is practical and entirely without valves, pistons or other complicated mechanism. It may be carried flat in the vest or coat pocket like a short lead pencil and without danger of leaking or losing. The Jack Knife Pen is well adapted for babies use since it may be dropped into a purse or hand bag with no risk to the other contents. It is doubly convenient when traveling as it can be tossed into a suit case or traveling bag with perfect safety.

The Jack Knife Safety Pen has two caps, the regular or outer cap which screws on over the nozzle and the inner or safety cap which fits inside the regular cap. When the outer cap has been properly screwed down after the writer is through using the pen, the threaded end of the safety cap should be taken a little turn, sufficiently hard to make a close contact between the end of the nozzle and the end of the inside (safety) cap. The gold pen then fits in an ink tight light compartment. Any ink that may come into this safety cap is drained back into the barrel when the pen is held point upward and the outer cap removed for writing. Any of these may be had with any style pen point and also in various style barrels, plain black, red, mottled or chased unless otherwise noted.

We have just added two fancy new numbers to our Jack Knife line, but which we are not able to illustrate here. Their descriptions are given below.

No. 45 Jack Knife Safety Pen, \$6.50

This follows closely the general design of our regular No. 47 but the size is that of No. 20 Jack Knife. Corrugated Pearl slabs of varying styles and colors are held in place by decorative gold bands. The cap is plain black, but mounted at the end with a pearl crown or a fancy stone setting (imitation amethyst, emerald, ruby, etc.)

No. 15 Jack Knife Safety Pen, \$7.00

Very similar in style to our regular No. 15, but the size is the same as No. 20 Jack Knife. Different varieties of pearl slabs are used and these are held in place by gold bands. The cap is covered with the same neat gold filigree that is used on No. 15. Space on cap for engraving name of owner. An exquisite pen bound to please.

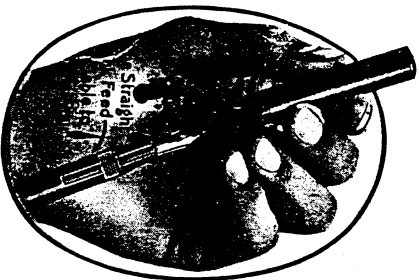

## THIS IS HOW THE PARKER LUCKY CURVE MAKES THE PARKER CLEANLY



Look at this illustration at the left—you've seen this inky accident happen often—perhaps it has happened to you. The cap full of ink when you take it off to write—inky fingers, soiled linen—it's a common occurrence with common fountain pens—in fact, with every fountain pen except the Parker. It's a seemingly little difference in the ink feed that makes the Parker proof against these irritating ink accidents.

These common pens that ink your fingers and soil your linen when you remove the cap to write all have straight ink feeds.

Straight ink feeds retain ink after you have returned the pen to your pocket. Then when air is expanded in the ink reservoir by the heat of your body the ink that is sticking in the straight ink feed is forced out into the cap, where you find it ready to ink your fingers and soil your linen the next time you remove the cap to write.

But the curved ink feed—the Lucky Curve of the Parker—is self-draining. The Lucky Curve just touches the inside wall of the reservoir, and as soon as you stop writing, capillary attraction drains the ink feed free of ink. No ink in the ink barrel before using if your fountain pen is a Parker—that's why you will never ink your fingers, soil your linen or need to wipe off the other pen has any device imitating or replacing the Lucky Curve.
