Not only are they made of rich materials—Italian marble, Pedra onyx, green Brazil onyx, black Vitrolite, enameled Metal, and Laminated Glass—but many now make their appearance in aristocratic styles, with gilt and silvered frames of the most artistic periods in the world's history. All bases (without pens) from \$1.00 to \$2.50 list price are supplied without tapers. If tapers are desired, beaded tapers will be supplied at 25c list extra. All bases at \$4.00 list price and over are furnished

with tapers. The list prices shown are for base with socket and taper only, without pen.

Orders for bases should specify the size socket wanted: Oversize Sockets for Oversize Vacumatic only. Standard Sockets for Standard Vacumatic, Junior Vacumatic, or Standard Challengers. Lady Sockets for Slender Vacumatic, Juniorette Vacumatic, and Slender Challengers.

Use your favorite pocket pen as desk pen.

Orders for double bases should specify not only the size of the socket, but also whether wanted for *two Pens or for Pen and Pencil*.

From Mr. Parker's Pen

Perhaps it may seem a little peculiar to you that this company is manufacturing something other than fountain pens, pencils, desk sets and ink, but such is the case.

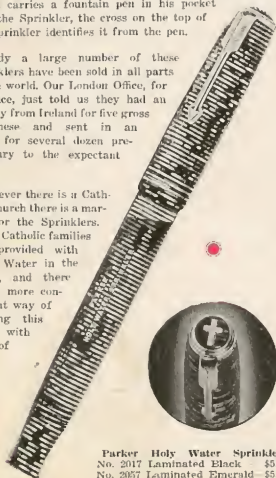
We have recently taken up the manufacture of a Holy Water Sprinkler. Catholics everywhere know well the use of the Holy Water Sprinkler.

These Holy Water Sprinklers are made so that they quite closely resemble the PARKER VACUMATIC fountain pen. They have, of course, no pen in them. They are semi-transparent so that the priest using one can see just how much Holy Water is in the barrel. They are very beautiful and can be carried in the pocket.

On the top of the cap is a gold cross, which makes it look somewhat ornamental and, at the same time, if the priest carries a fountain pen in his pocket with the Sprinkler, the cross on the top of the Sprinkler identifies it from the pen.

Already a large number of these Sprinklers have been sold in all parts of the world. Our London Office, for instance, just told us they had an inquiry from Ireland for five gross of these and sent in an order for several dozen preliminary to the expectant order.

Wherever there is a Catholic church there is a market for the Sprinklers. Many Catholic families are provided with Holy Water in the home, and there is no more convenient way of keeping this than with one of

the Holy Water Sprinklers, so that the use of these Sprinklers is not confined solely to the priests.

May we suggest this thought—

A great many of the Sprinklers which are sold are sold as presents. The church societies like to give their favorite priest some little present and what finer or more appropriate gift could be given him than one of these beautiful Sprinklers and, especially so, if accompanied by a PARKER VACUMATIC so that the priest will then be provided with not only a Sprinkler but the highest type of fountain pen made—the PARKER VACUMATIC.

It's worth your while to devote a little of your selling energy to this new item. While the sale will not be large, yet whatever sales are made is just that much extra.

Another new item is the Bridge Pencil with the New International Score. This is an absolute novelty.

We would somewhat of a try-out to see if there was any demand for this and almost before we knew it, our travelers had sent in orders for several thousand of them as the trade seem to recognize in this article something that would have a strong public demand, for Bridge is played everywhere.

They are very popularly priced and a present of a set of four of these to any hostess would be a delightful presentation.

Not long since one of our representatives on the road, Mr. Lee P. Benton, wrote us in regard to a young man in his territory, in Humboldt, Iowa, who is doing some fine fountain pen selling.

Humboldt, Iowa, is a small town of only a little over 2,000 population. You would think under the circumstances that the opportunities for selling fountain pens and pencils in a town of this size would be somewhat limited, but the young man employed in the drug store in that town, Mr. Royal Bennett, did not think so.

Do you know what he did? He compiled a list of people whom he thought ought to buy a PARKER pen or pencil. Then he turned his thought batteries on these people and made them acquainted with PARKER pens.

When you learn what he accomplished, you may think that the returns were a little astonishing. From the first of November 1934 up to the first of May, this year, he sold at retail \$300.00 worth of PARKER products. This, please remember, was in a little town of only a little over 2,000 inhabitants.

The writer wishes to say he calls this a fine record.

The writer took the liberty of writing this young man, telling him that he was very much pleased with the record he had made and invited him to visit the factory. During his vacation a short time ago, he accepted our invitation.

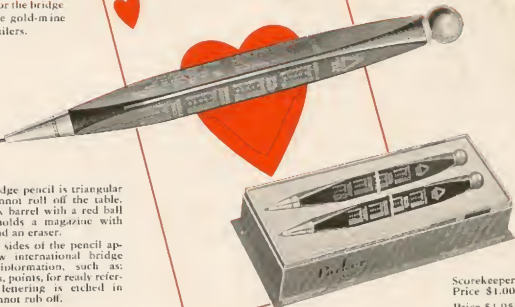
We found Royal to be a bright, unassuming young chap and a regular interrogation mark for information. He went through the plant, saw how gold pens are made, how the pens are tipped with iridium, saw the gold melted in an electrical retort; he also went through the noisy Automatic Department. He expressed surprise at the big machines and so many of them used in making PARKER pens.

When he got through, he knew the interesting story of the manufacture of PARKER pens so that he could in turn pass it on to the customer.

The Parker Bridge Pencil and Scorekeeper

A new idea for the bridge fan — a little gold-mine for gift retailers.

This new bridge pencil is triangular so that it cannot roll off the table. It has a black barrel with a red ball end which holds a magazine with extra leads and an eraser. On the three sides of the pencil appear the new international bridge rules with information, such as: honors, tricks, points, for ready reference. This lettering is etched in silver and cannot rub off.

There is really quite a romance in connection with the making of fountain pens as you would see if you visited the plant—when you take into consideration that the iridium which is used on the point of the pen comes from far-off Tasmania or the Ural Mountains in Russia; the gold that is used in the pens comes from the bowels of the earth; the pyroxilin that is used in the holders represents one of the most highly specialized arts in the manufacturing business today.

Then Mr. Bennett visited the beautiful Parker Club House where so many young people of the big Parker family congregate noons and evenings—all like one large family.

It was worth considerable to Mr. Bennett to see the more than 700 people working in the plant, all busily engaged in producing PARKER products.

If you visit the Parker Pen plant, the writer would be very pleased to have you visit his summer home wherein is installed some rather interesting Oriental objects which the writer has gathered in his pilgrimages about the world.

One, for instance, is a Buddhist Shinto Shrine such as they use in the Orient and the only one the writer has ever seen in the United States. Here it was that the Prince and Princess Svasti and Prince Arjuna of the Royal Siamese Party worshipped when they were guests of Mrs. Parker and the writer some three years ago.

These are only a few of a number of rather interesting Oriental carvings which are placed on the writer's estate in very similar arrangements to those found in China, Ceylon and India.

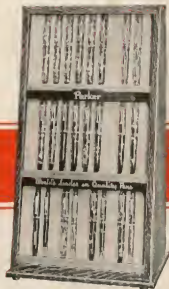
