#### SUCTION FILLING STYLES

A self filling style of perfect action, without any complicated parts, of the highest quality and finest manufacture, which the trade mark guarantees. There are no soft rubber parts to be affected by acids in the ink. The sucker plunger is fitted with a tapered cork which, when drawn in place, fits in a taper bore in the ink barrel (as a cork in a bottle) which makes it absolutely air and ink tight. The pen is the same shape and balance as our standard makes and the cap is fitted with chain.

While we do not think any self filling pen equal to our standard styles, they are preferred by some.

### DIRECTIONS FOR FILLING HOUSTON SUCTION FILLING PENS.

Unscrew cap over pen point; also remove tapered cap over plunger. This cap is only friction tight and can be removed more easily by turning slightly either right or left. Push plunger str ight down as far as possible; emerge gold pen in the ink up to the rubber, draw plunger back slowly as you would in a syringe. Draw plunger back securely as this fills pen completely and corks end of barrel. Replace taper cap.



#### SAFETY CHAINS

This picture shows the proper place to attach the safety chain to the vest. When pen is in use the cap remains on the chain. When not in use the cap screws onto the holder and pen is inserted in pocket as in cut above. When worn in outside coat pocket, secure chain to coat under the lapel far enough above pocket to take up full length of chain.

The proper way to wear the lady's pen is to secure safety hook to shirtwaist in the desired position and then slip ring on cap end of chain over the tongue on the hook, and allow it to hang as in cut.

To carry pen in hand bag or grip, secure the chain to side of bag.

The holders affords an easy grip and balance; the gold pens contain sufficient stock to admit of the finest temper; the feed is the size which gives the best air regulation. Combining these three most essential features the Houston No. 4 and 5 are the acme of pen perfection.

The majority of clerical people today are not using fountain pens for the simple reason that the desired state of perfection has not been reached by other manufacturers. A trial of the "HOUSTON" will convince any bookkeeper, open to conviction, that it has the old steel dip pen "beaten to a frazzle."

In these sizes we make the needle point, which is the bookkeeper's special, the fine, medium, coarse, stub, oblique (for the back hand writer) and the manifold.

For those who desire a larger ink reservor and large pen for heavy shading, we recommend our numbers 7 and 8, both of which will be found equal to any test they might be put to and will give service for a life time.

The Baby Grand and No. 2 are our ladies' pens. While the other styles may be used by ladies, they are not so convenient.




