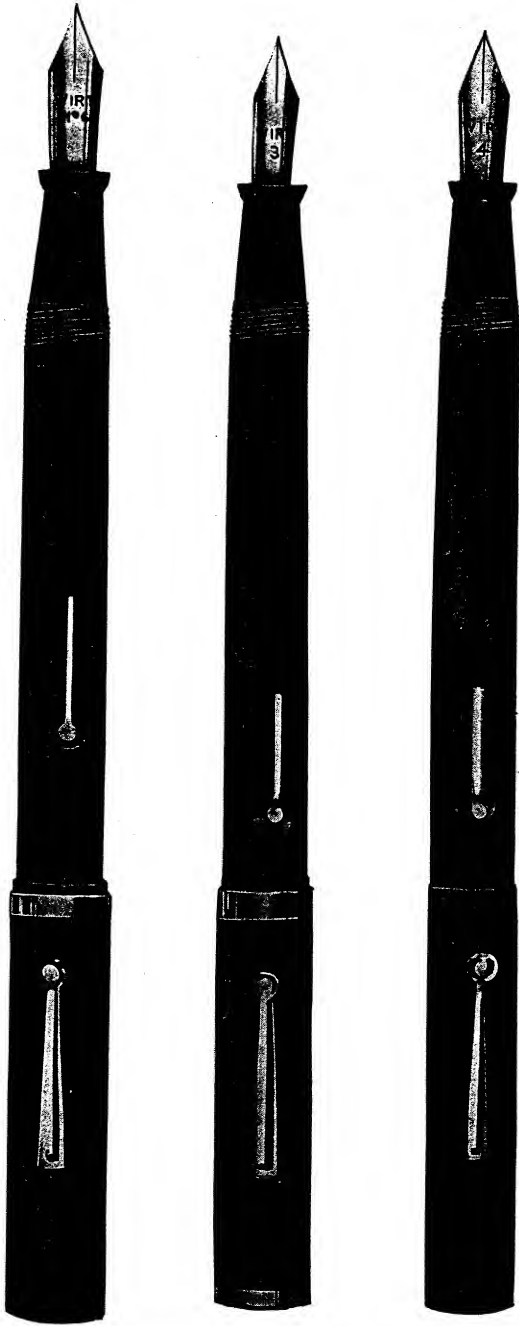

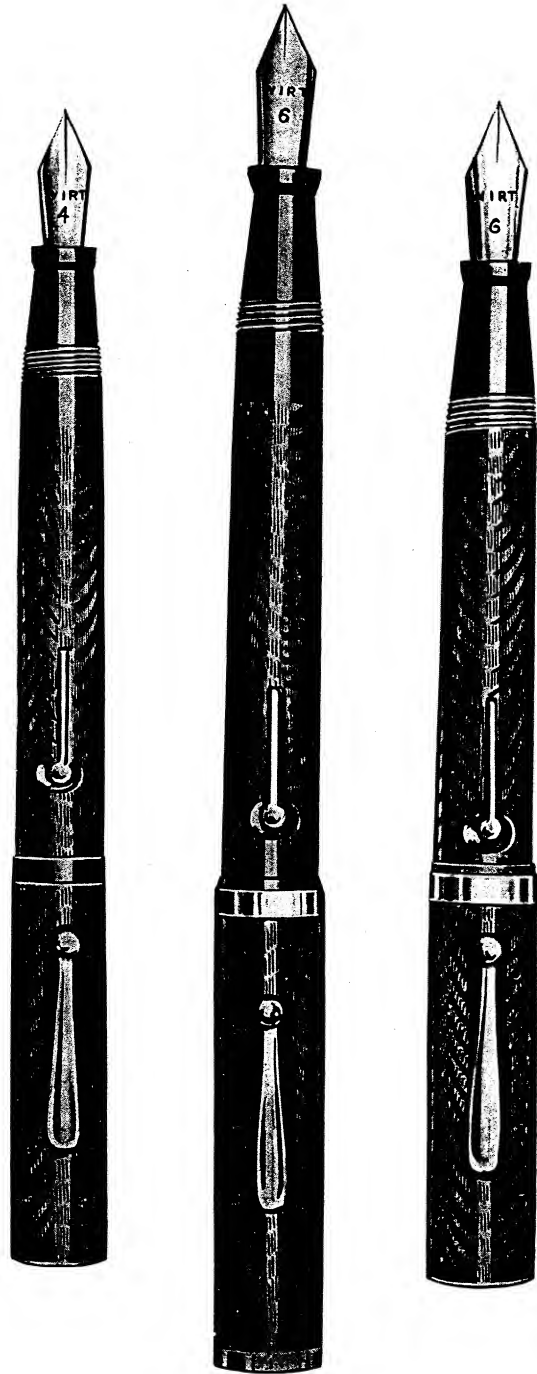

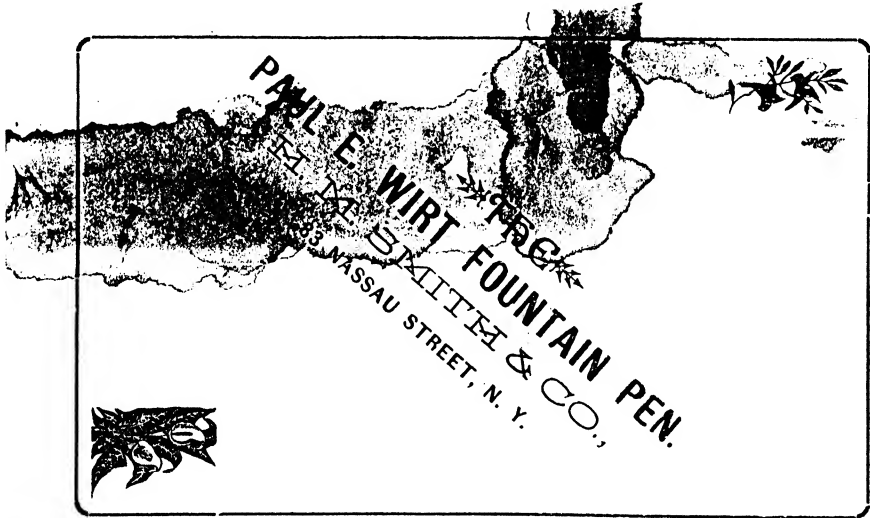

DURABLE gold pen of any desired flexibility, reliably supplied with ink sufficient for several days' writing, from a hard rubber holder, that may be carried in the pocket without leaking, or damage to pen. The advantages claimed for this pen over other fountain pens are, that it is

**DURABLE,**  
**PRACTICAL,**

**RELIABLE,**  
and absolutely without complications. The case and gold pen are incorrodible, and with proper care will last a lifetime.

It is practical because it is simple in construction and can be used in the same manner as any other gold or steel pen.

It is reliable because the ink will invariably flow and the pen will always write. It may be filled and left for weeks without being used, and when opened the pen will write as readily as if just filled.

There are no spiral wires, air valves or other complicated machinery, to get out of order. It is the simplest, clearest, most reliable and easily managed of all fountain pens.

**DIRECTIONS.**

- (1.) Carry in the Pocket with Pen Up.
  - (2.) In filling unscrew nozzle in which the pen is fixed, fill the case full; replace nozzle *tightly*.
  - (3.) Before Using, if the pen is new or dry, take off the nozzle and wet it thoroughly, inside and around the pen and shaft. The pen once moistened will remain so, and always be ready for use.
  - (4.) Avoid suddenly inverting or violently shaking it so as to force the ink from the case unnecessarily and cause blotting.
  - (5.) If the ink flows too freely, or will not flow at all refill the case. Too much ink on the pen indicates that the case needs refilling—do not be caught with an empty pen.
  - (6.) Fluid Inks are the best. Avoid runny or muddy inks.
  - (7.) Keep Cap over Pen when not in use to prevent evaporation of ink.
  - (8.) Fill the Case every day, where constant daily office work is done with the pen.
  - (9.) Twist or Wind the cap off; do not pull it off straight.
