These little inkwells possess the same Self-Closing features as all other "Sengbusch" Inkstands, yet are constructed differently. In the regular "Sengbusch" commercial stands the hard rubber buoyant float is incased in a hard rubber casing, commonly termed the "fountain." In the Nos. 62, 63 and 64 this same float operates in a glass sleeve set in a cork gasket. The Nos. 62, 63 and 64 are bought chiefly where space does not permit using the larger "Sengbusch" stands; otherwise the latter are preferred.



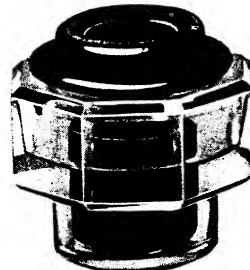

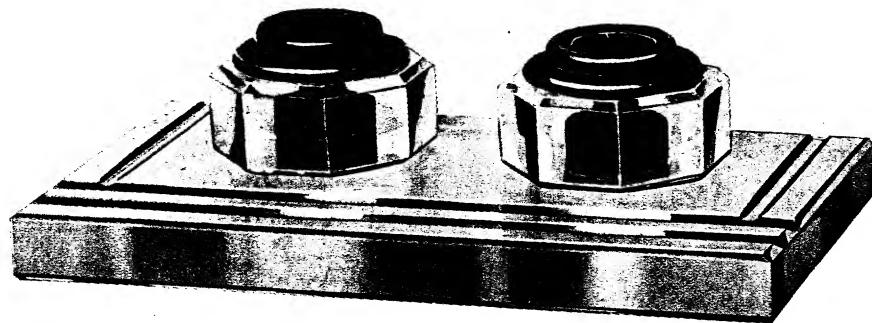

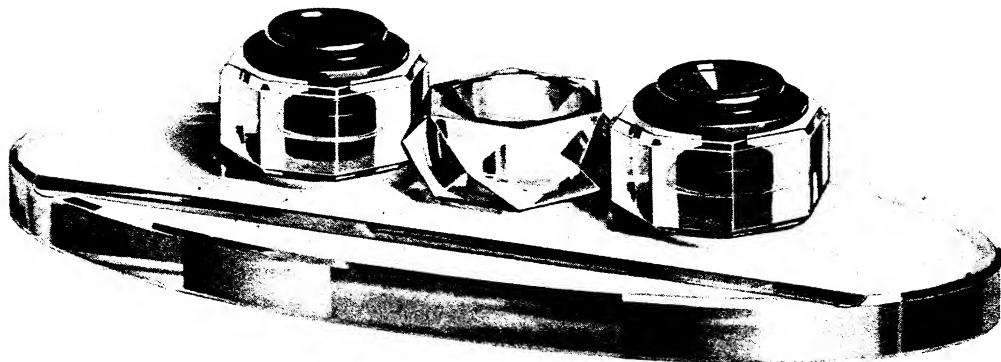

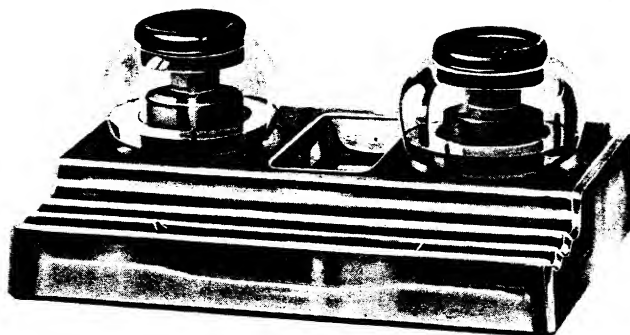

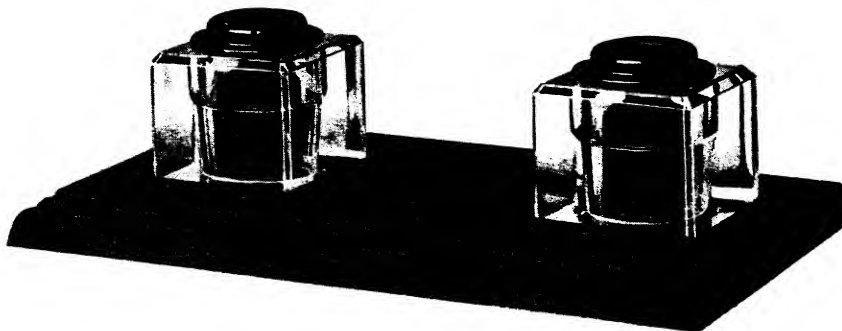

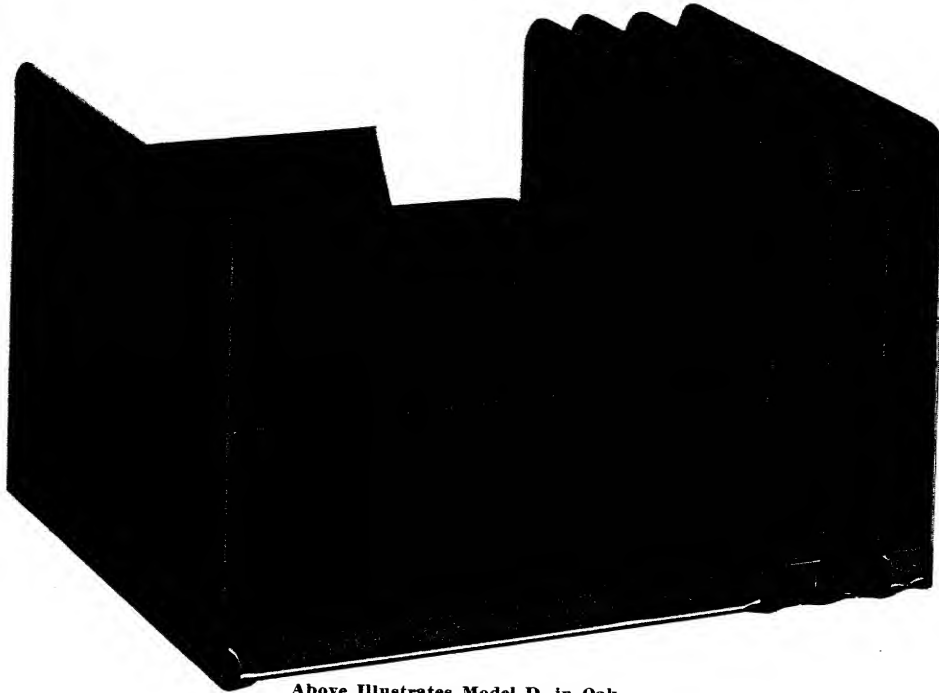
