- A fennec fox is **smaller than** a camel.

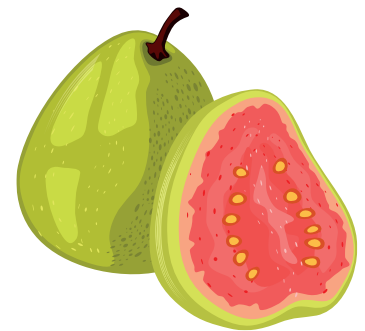

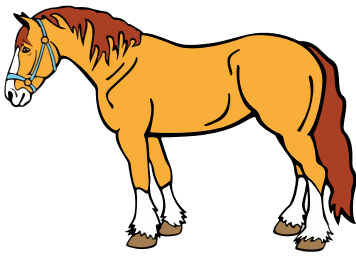
