BILLY WAYNE WILSON, DOB APRIL 14, 1958,

This day came again the Attorney for the Commonwealth, and Billy Wayne Wilson who stands convicted of a felony, to wit: unlawfully, feloniously, and with lascivious intent, did propose to a child fifteen years of age, an act of sexual intercourse, said Billy Wayne Wilson being over the age of eighteen years as charged in the indictment, appeared according to the condition of his recognizance and came also David A. Helesco, his attorney.

And the Probation Officer of this Court, to whom this case has been previously referred for investigation, appeared in open Court with a written report, which report he presented to the Court in open Court in the presence of the defendant who was fully advised of the contents of the report and a copy of said report was previously delivered to counsel for the accused.

Thereupon the defendant and his counsel were given the right to cross-examine the Probation Officer as to any matter contained in the said report and to present any additional facts bearing upon the matter as they desired to present. The report of the Probation Officer was filed as a part of the record in this case.

Whereupon the Court taking into consideration all of the evidence in the case, the report of the Probation Officer, the matters brought out on cross-examination of the Probation Officer and such additional facts as were presented by the defendant, and it being demanded of the defendant if anything to be said why judgment should not be pronounced against him according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, the Court withholds imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for an indefinite period under the supervision of a probation officer of this Court and under the general conditions of probation as heretofore adopted by this Court and further condition that he see a psychiatrist every two weeks and the psychiatrist shall furnish the Court with a report every three months.

The Court certifies that at all times during the trial of this case the defendant was personally present and the attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.

Thereupon the defendant was allowed to depart and this case is removed the active docket with leave to reinstate.
