1. Limit the personal information you share online.
2. Don't sign up for a website if it asks for too much personal information.
3. Use different strong passwords.
4. Use anti-virus software.
5. Update your devices regularly.

Back up your data

To back up your data you can use :

1. Some apps and software programs that back up data automatically.
2. A data-storage devices such as :
 - flash drive
 - external hard disk drive
3. A hybrid backup is a safer way to back up and store files.
4. The hard disk has more space than the Flash Memory.

Lesson 3 : Password security

Phishing and Smishing

- ▶ Phishing and smishing are ways used by hackers to get your password.
- ▶ Phishing is a message via e-mail or social media that looks real, but isn't.

Types of phishing scam :

1. A message which says that you have won a prize, but have to give your bank account details.
 2. When an attachment, or a file is opened data-stealing software is installed on the person's computer, or the user is asked to enter sensitive information such as bank account details.
- ▶ Ways of identifying phishing messages :
 1. include misspelled words and grammar errors.
 2. include requests for too much personal data.
 - ▶ Smishing is the same thing but it is a text message instead of an e-mail.

How can we identify phishing?

It contains spelling and grammar errors Request for too many personal date .

Smishing:

is the same thing but is a text message instead of an e-mail.

Password management software:

Multi-factor authentication(MFA) :

To prevent hackers from accessing your account and data in two ways:

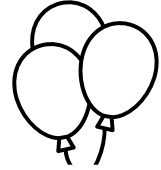

Protecting your personal data

- ◆ personal information: such as your name, address, date of birth, and your passwords.
- ◆ This personal information is called **Personally Identifiable Information (PII)**.

hackers can use:

- 2- You can use a data-storage device that you attach to your computer,
 - a. a flash drive

- This is called a **hybrid backup**. It is a safer way to back up and store files.
- The hard disk has more space than the Flash Memory, but it may also be used for the same purpose.
- An external hard disk drive is one of the accessories that you can use to save your files securely, and backup copies of your files that are important and private to you to prevent the possibility of losing them on your device.

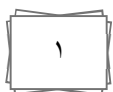

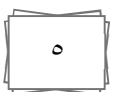
