How to Form the Zero Conditional

If + present simple, present simple

Examples of the Zero Conditional

- If you mix blue and yellow colors, you get green.
- If you touch fire, you get burned.
- If you don't study, you won't pass the exam.
- If it rains, the streets get wet.
- If you plant a seed, it grows into a plant.

Zero Conditional Rules


1. Use the present simple tense in both the if clause and the main clause.

promova

- 2. Use "if" at the beginning of the sentence to introduce the condition.
- **3.** Add a comma to separate the "if" clause from your main clause.
- 4. The order of the clauses does not matter.

Note:

- We could use "when " instead of " if "
