The sustained and tremendous popularity of Latin American Rhythms in the United States has made musical by-words of rumba, samba, beguine and tango — affording the rampant mushroom growth of almost a hundred thousand fan clubs and dancing schools throughout the nation.

The rumba was the first Latin American rhythm to attract public attention back in 1931 when the famous Palace theater in New York City featured a rumba band on its vaudeville bill. For a while it caught on slowly — and then only as a novelty. But during the late thirties and all through the forties America grew more and more rumba conscious, with every leading night club, dance hall, theater, hotel and radio network featuring at least one rumba band. Today Latin American music has assumed an important role in our entertainment way of life, with the songs and dances of our south-of-the-border neighbors being accepted as an integral part of our Anglo-Saxon culture.

Two ubiquitous but unheralded bandleaders who are forthright responsible for the expansive popularity of the rumba, samba, etc., on this continent are JOSE MORAND and JOSE BETHANCOURT. Both Morand and Bethancourt are recognized in the field of music as the two foremost authorities and exponents of Latin rhythms in the world today. Leading their own dance and concert orchestras in national and international tours, they have also served as technical directors of Latin American music for many movies, records and song publishers.

Maestros MORAND and BETHANCOURT have elected to present in ARRIBA LATIN AMERICA a popular selection of universally known North and South American melodies, interpreted and magnificently arranged in the diversified and exotic rhythms of the tropics. Their talented aggregations are replete with full string, brass and reed sections and also include the native instruments that brilliantly underscore and accentuate the sensuous beat of the music. Also interperated in this album are the exciting and stimulating vocals of the Harris Trio and the fervid voice of Marion Mann.
