

These are the raw MOCR audio files. The naming convention is:

"A11_T648_HR1U_CH1_02-47-56_11-17-56_-_2015-10-01_Recording.wav"

The first number ("A11") is the mission recorded.

The second series of characters ("T648") is the tape number this file was digitized from.

The third series of characters ("HR1U") refers to tape machine the audio was originally recorded upon. "HR" means Historical Recorder and "1U, 2U, 1L or 2L" refers to the number of the machine and its location in the rack: Upper or Lower. The tape recorders were setup in a cascading fashion so that one recorder would begin near the end of tape on another to ensure uninterrupted continuous recording.

The fourth series of characters refers to the Channel number or track number. Reference the track sheet photographs for MOCR loop channel assignments: Historical_Recorder_1_Tracksheet, and Historical_Recorder_2_Tracksheet.
