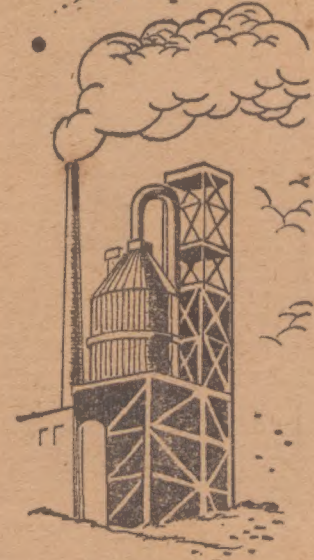

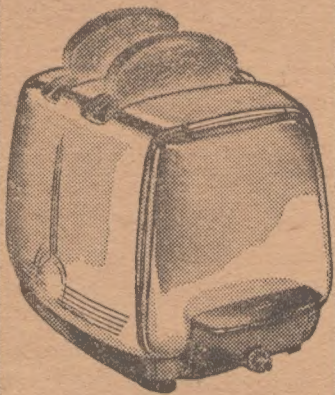
Our "Girl Of The Week" Today

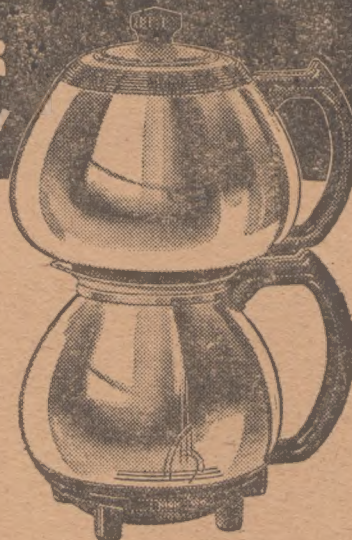

This survey — the 4th. of its kind since the establishment of parity (100) for the new index as of September 1, 1951 — for the first time showed a downward trend in the cost of living.

As a consequence, the cost of living bonus granted Lago employees will be reduced from 1.569% of regular and overtime earnings to 1.243%. On Thursday last, day following the inventory, a considerable increase in prices of certain items at the Lago Commissary was noted, however, and one wonders if this decline will continue to show for any length of time.

The local police authorities have informed us that a number of owners of motor vehicles have not complied with traffic regulations and police instructions to have their vehicle tested for roadability in spite of the fact that they were sent police notices showing the date and time of inspection.

People using vehicles which are not approved by the police are

breaking the law.

The police is now offering another opportunity to such vehicle owners to report with their vehicles for testing at the inspection building located at the Theaterstreet, San Nicolas, behind the Police Station, before September 15, 1952.

The inspection building is opened on:

- Mondays from 8 to 11.30 and 14 to 18 o'clock
- Tuesdays from 8 to 11.30 and Closed in p.m.
- Wednesdays from 8 to 11.30 and 13.30 to 16 o'clock
- Tursdays from 8 to 11.30 and Closed in p.m.
- Fridays from 8 to 11.30 and 14 to 18 o'clock

For the information of all concerned, drivers should at all times have the card issued by the police and showing that the vehicle has been tested and approved for roadability, with them while using said vehicle. They should also have with them at all times a valid driver's license and paid license receipt. This license (tax) receipt must be presented to the police when reporting with the vehicle for test purposes at the inspection building.

In their own interest, owners of motor vehicles are urged to comply with the above and cooperate with the police.

**LAGO LISTS "OUTSIDE
NUMBERS.**

As a result of a suggestion made through their "Coin Your Ideas" system, the Lago has agreed to list the "outside" residence telephone numbers of its locally hired employees now listed in the Lago's telephone directory in the "residence" column of said directory. This is another courtesy which the Lago readily extended to its locally hired employees and which, no doubt, will help improving employee-employer relations.

A similar courtesy extended to the government telephone subscribers working for Lago would prove

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SPORT BOXING

BOXING IN ARUBA

A sparsely filled Arena National was the scene of a fair boxing card presented by Promotor J. Eusebio Croes and Matchmaker 'Long Gun' on August 23, 1952.

Re-instated Sugar Boy Nando, whom the reader recalls, drew a 6 months suspension from the Aruba Boxing Commission for his three rounds waltz act with Battling Siki a few months ago, redeemed himself. In a good exhibition of boxing he outcuted smart Battling Nelson in 10 rounds to gain a split decision.

In the curtain raiser Curley Kayo suffered his first defeat against Aruba Chocolate on a unanimous

decision in 3 rounds.

Next in the roped square Luciano Kid and Kid Curacao, a couple of scrappy lightweights, went at one another for six rounds. Luciano received the nod on a split decision. Judge Nassy voted in favor of the Curacao lad.

The second 6-round fracas featured the two crowd pleasing welters Young Quick Silver and Kid Bellot. Kid Bellot proved again that he has a granite jaw by stopping mercurious opponent's right swings with that part of his anatomy. It appeared that Quick Silver was coasting to an easy victory, the official verdict however was a draw. All 3 officials scored this one differently. Judge Oduber voted a draw, Referee Hochstuhl gave it to Bellot and Judge Nassy scored 5 of the 6 rounds in favor of Quick Silver.

In the main bout, scheduled for

10 stanzas, the two most popular local fighters did some sleek boxing. Battling Nelson at 164 lbs. spotted Sugar Boy Nando by 10 pounds. The Sugar Boy offset this advantage in avoirdupois by excellent footwork and good use of his rapier like left. Judge Oduber scored 6 rounds even, 3 for Nando and 1 for Nelson, Judge Nassy 5 for Nando, 1 even and 4 for Nelson. Referee Hochstuhl saw it the other way around viz. 4, 1 and 5.

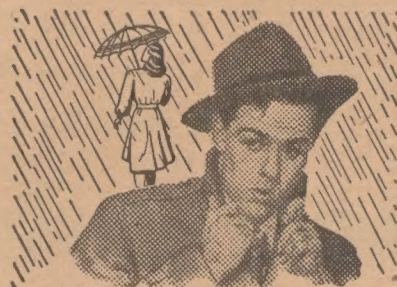

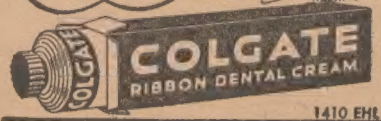

CANADIAN GRAIN EXPORTS SET RECORD.

OTTAWA (Vaz Dias) Canadian exports of grain reached an all-time record in the crop year ending July 31, 1952, stated the Minister of Trade and Commerce recently.

Preliminary returns indicate grain exports of 509 million bushels for the crop year 1951-52. Exports of wheat and flour amounted to 357 million bushels while 72 million bushels of oats and 70 million bushels of barley were cleared for export during the crop year.

POSTWAR HIGH SCORED IN EXPORT OF SILK.

TOKYO (Vaz Dias) Silk exports hit a postwar high in July with raw silk amounting to 4,000 bales and dupion 2,005 bales, according to figures released last week by the Agriculture-Forestry Ministry.

The Ministry does not entertain a rosy outlook on silk exports. It says an advance in silk price is in prospect, and transactions in futures are scarce. Besides, in triangular trade transferable sterling is decreasing and the difference has dropped to 5 percent.

World News

BERLIN.

United States, Great Britain and France jointly rejected Soviet allegations that they were taking measures to reduce trade between East and West Germany.

The allegations were made by

Russian General of the Army Vasily Chuikov in a letter dated July 30.

U.S. High Commissioner Walter J. Donnelly said in his letter "I cannot understand nor accept" the allegations that Western authorities are responsible for reducing the flow of trade between West and East Germany.

The Russians had accused the three Western powers of breaking the 1949 agreement that ended the Soviet blockade of Berlin.

General Chuikov — Soviet Commander in East Germany — blamed a decline in trade between zones of the divided nation on Western restrictions.

In his reply, Mr. Donnelly pointed to the existence of the two currently operative trade agreements between the West and East Germany and declared:

"If there is a genuine desire on the part of the Soviet occupation authorities to maintain conditions conducive to the proper functioning of these agreements, there is every reason to be confident that the implementation thereof will be satisfactory to both East and West Germany".

EGYPT.

Premier Aly Maher, says he expects to open talks with Britain about the Anglo-Egyptian dispute over the Suez Canal Zone and the Sudan next three months. After he has cleaned up the "economic mess" in Egypt and prepared for new elections.

The Premier told a news conference this week, in setting a tentative date for the formal talks between the two countries, he hopes condition in Egypt will be returned to normal by that time.

U. S. A.

The United States Senate Committee Published an official report which had been suppressed for a year, alleging that seven International Oil Companies held the monopoly of the world's oil-divided markets between them and fixed

A new long-term aid to Britain programme is being considered in United States Government circles.

The programme which would be initiated in the first year of the new Administration to be elected next November has been outlined in a memorandum now circulating in all departments of the Mutual Security Agency responsible for the Administration of the United States foreign aid programme.

They emphasize, however, that it involves an entirely new approach to the question of enabling Britain and the Sterling Area to establish a real and permanent trading balance with the dollar area without continuing deficits.

This would give stability to the economics of the Sterling Area countries and assist them in making long term plans to restore the balance of trade between the Sterling and Dollar Areas.

* * *

General Eisenhower, Republican Presidential Candidate addressed 15,000 Ex-servicemen of the American Legion at Madison Square

Garden Stadium, who greeted him with shouts and cheers. "We want Ike".

He was introduced by the Legion National Commander, Mr. Donald R. Wilson, as a "great leader whom it was our privilege to follow to victory." In a thirty minutes address he said that Russia was preparing for a third world war which would meet America in greater peril than anytime in her history, but she still had time to prepare, and that Stalin knows America does not quit "They do not forsake their principles nor quail from sacrifice."

He believes that the Kremlin will constantly build towards war if war is deemed necessary to the achievements of a global end and that

meanwhile it will precede with its campaign of political infiltration and economic strangulation. He added "we must tell the Soviet with cold finality that never shall we rest until the tidal mud of aggressive communism has receded within its own border.

Eisenhower outlined a programme designed to present Counter-measure to the Soviet movements. They include:

(1) Creating a security force with such offensive impact that the massive potential of their blows will haunt the Kremlin with nightmares of the punishment to be visited on Russia should it violate the peace.

(2) Greater co-operative unity with every nation in the free world that is prepared to stand with us, work with us, build with us, for the security of all of us.

(3) A warning to Russia that the United States will never recognise the slightest permanence in Russia's position in Eastern Europe and Asia.

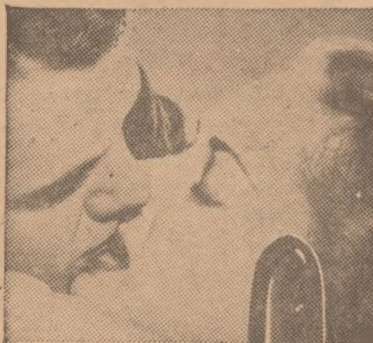

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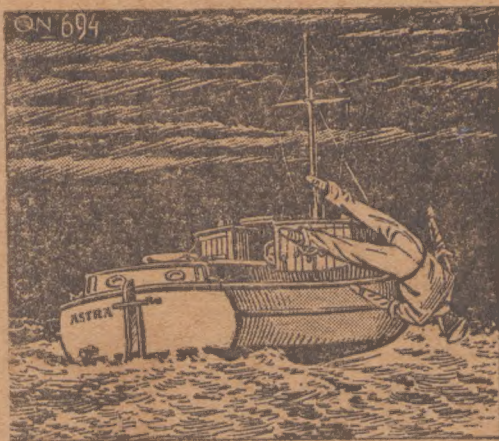
