

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE CHILDREN OF "LOCAL" AND "FOREIGN STAFF" EMPLOYEES.

When Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, said "Suffer little children to come unto me". His statement was not intended to discriminate or segregate His children, He did not refer to a particular race, caste or creed of children. He did not mean "locally hired" children or "foreign staff" children. He meant ALL His children.

However, Lago interprets this to mean "foreign staff" children.

For some time now the Special Problems Advisory Committee has been trying very hard to get Lago to accept the children of "locally hired" employees for treatment at the hospital up to age eighteen --- at present they may only enjoy medical facilities up to age 15. Lago has said NO each time. However, the children of "foreign staff" employees may enjoy medical facilities up to age 18. Why the distinction between the children?

We know the vast difference between the wages of "local" and "foreign staff" employees, and we know that the medical facilities at Lago are far more cheaper and better than the one privately owned Since Lago is hospital outside. aware of all this too, why is the company so adverse to granting their suppressed "locals" a facility which would alleviate their present hardships? We know Lago is not a philantropic organization, but is least six months should they be

2.6% INCREASE IN ARUBA'S POPULATION

According to official reports Aruba's population during 1951 increased by 2.6 per cent. The population increased by 1.731 men and 1.846 women (by births and new settlements). It decreased by 1.291 men and 846 women (due to deaths and departures). At the end of Decem-

ber 1951, therefore, the population stood at 28.667 male and 25.964 female residents. Total population 54.631. Population increase of 2.6%.

ARUBA HOTEL PLANS ON THE MOVE

It is understood that plans for the hotels for Curacao and Aruba are beginning to take on some real meaning. According to recent reports a preliminary plan has been drafted and this will be reviewed further when a number of interested U.S. business men arrive in this Territory. It is now proposed to build 100-room hotel at Curacao and one at Aruba (near the Roosevelt House and at Palm Beach, respectively) with a swimming pool at both places. Furthermore, at each island (in Aruba at Palm Beach and at Curacao near the Nieuw. port Beach) one hundred cabanas

Apart from this, Aruba is to get an additional ten or twenty 2-and 3-room bungalows. The U.S. architect Robert Law Weed will be charged with designing the entire plan. Robert Law Weed is well-known in Aruba. He designed the Lago Hospital, Esso Club, etc. and also designed a number of hotels in the Caribbean area.

All plans are subject to change. The sketches will be studied here and a final plan will be drawn no thereafter. Not until then will the purchase of materials, which will be obtained mainly from Holland, be studied as well as the construction of the projects which it is hoped can be carried out by local contractors.

NEW EMPLOYEE REPRESEN-TATION PLAN FOR CPIM **EMPLOYEES**

At 11.00 a.m. on September 6, 1952 the recently elected new CPIM Employee Council was officially installed by Dr. Flachs. All members of management and a large majority of the department heads and many officials were present during the installation ceremony.

The newly elected Council is part of the revised representation plan for CPIM employees. Part of the new plan calls for district councils to assist in less important phases of employee representation than that handled by the CPIM E.C.

According to the election returns there was a 89.9% participation and 15.225 valid votes "The Small Store with the were cast.

The new Council comprises of seven eligible employees and has no nationality split. Dr. Flachs appealed to the members of Netherlands nationality to accept in their midst and as their colleagues the members of foreign nationality. The Council should consider itself as one representative body for the protection of the interests of all employees, regardless of their nationality or function.

"ESSO AMSTERDAM" ADRIFT

On September 2 the main motor of the "Esso Amsterdam", 1000 kilometers west of the Azores, went out of commission due to a short circuit. All efforts on the part of the ship's personnel to repair the damage were in vain. The seatug "Humber" was sent to assist the stranded ship and was scheduled to reach her on September 10. The ship will be towed to the Azores where she is expected to arrived on September 18. The "Esso Amsterdam", as 16.000-ton ship of the tanker fleet "Esso Nederland" came from Mexico with a cargo of aviation gasoline for Rotterdam. All is well on board.

World News

EGYPT.

Premier Aly Maher resigned last weekend and General Naguib, Army Commander in Chief, took over as Prime Minister of the new Government. He also retained his position as Minister of the Army and Marine.

One of his first actions was to round up several outstanding politicians, including seven members of ex-King Farouk's family, who were alleged to be grafters. Among those arrested were the former premiers, Ahmed Hilaly and Abrahim Abdel Hadi, the boss of the Wafdist Party, Faud Serag Edin.

In the new Cabinet are six members of the anti-British Nationalist, Party. No Army men are in the Cabinet and an Army spokesman stated that General Naguib would resign as soon as normal parliamentary rule is restored.

The country is remaining quiet, but it was reported that the British forces in Suez Canal Zone and the Sudan were reinforced.

ENGLAND.

This week Mr. Churchill promised that his Government will introduce measures in November to denationalise the country's steel and trucking industries

He stated that the Labor Government did not have time to carry out the complete socialisation of the industries and the separate identity and independence of the great steel

PLANE CRASHES AT AIR SHOW

Over 120.000 persons at the Farnborough air show witnessed grim tragedy when Britain's newest jet fighter, De Haviland 110, after showing some of its paces, suddenly zoomed to a height of 2.000 feet and disintegrated completely.

At the time of disintegration, the plane was traveling at more than 700 m.p.h. with one of Britain ace fliers, John Derry at the controls. The wreckage of one jet engine plummed into a group of spectators killing twentyfive, and injuring about 36.

The crowd remained calm and the show went on as if nothing had hap-

pened. An investigation into the cause of the accident was held on Monday but findings were not announced.

While blood donations will continue to be necessary for rehabilitation treatment, the blood extender is suitable for emergency use under disaster conditions during the first 12 to 24 hours.

STEEL HARBOR

Long Beach, California (Vaz Diaz) - An artificial steel harbor is under construction here to protect vessels from violent gales and strong wave preasure. According to the American Iron and Steel Institute, violent seas will be checked by interlocking steel piling. Sand-filled circular piles, it is explained, can stand pressures of 8.000 nounds per linear inch at interlocking points. The artificial steel harbor will offer a haven for the largest ships.

REMOVE CON-TROL TELEVISION CAMERA

Washington (Vaz Dias) Formerly inaccessible places are now within reach of an improved remote control television camera developed by the General Precision Laboratory, Inc. of Pleasant-

ville. Made to swing sideways as well as up and down and furnished with four lenses, the camera can operate from a thousand feet distance. In television network this improves gadget makes the often disturbing physical presence of the cameraman unnecessary. It will be handy for strategic positions, as it can work for long hours from behind all sorts of camouflage such as flower displays, artistic decorations etc. used at conventions or any public events. The camera is also important for military use.

INGENIOUS MOSQUITO KILLER

San Francisco (Vaz Dias) - An epidemic of sleeping sickness in California's fertile Central Valley is being halted by a novel method of combating the mosquitoes which transmit the dread disease. A new wetting detergent called H20K which diminishes the surface tension of water in being sprayed on stagnant pools and marshland. As a result the young mosquito larvae which developed from the eggs floating in the water, immediately sink through the surface and are destroved before they can start their deadly work. The detergent is inexpensive and believed to be more effective than DDT against which mosquitoes have built up considerable immunity.

PEACEFUL SNORKEL

Fort Madison (Vaz Dias) - A new type of fountain pen said to end all inkspot and filling troubles is about to be launched by the Sheaffer Pen Co. to the tune of a multi-million dollar advertising campaing. Claimed to be "mess-proof" the pen is called the "Snorkel" after an extensible filling tube resembling the World War II invention which permitted submarines to breathe under water. The Snorkel fills up with ink without any other part of the pen — or fingers — coming in touch with the fluid.
