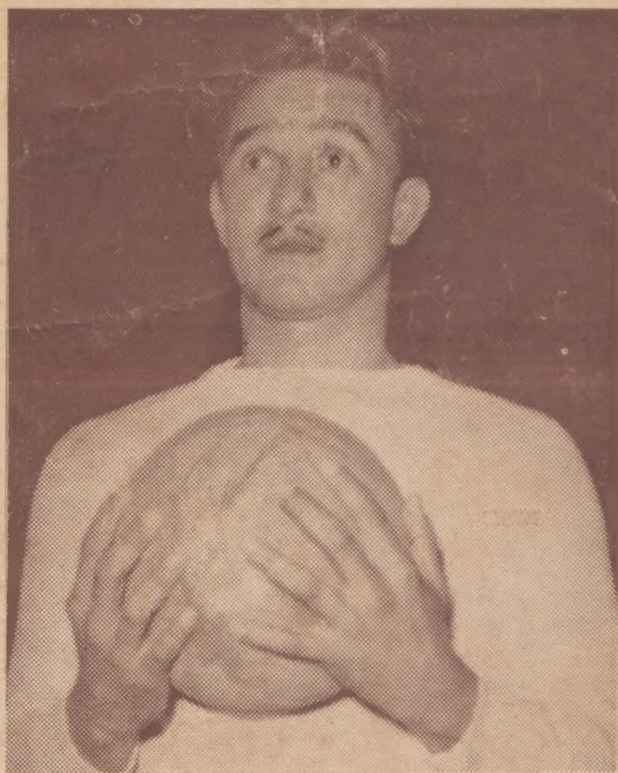

centre forward until 1939. Then he kept goal for this team until 1942.

From 1942 he continued as a custodian but now for the Savaneta Camp team. In 1944, the team of the Aruba Football Association travelled to Curacao to play ball. Their goal was defended by Mateo Reyes. This is when our sportin'ality's glorious years as Aruba's Ace custodian began, and that same year when Aruba defended its colors in Surinam, Mateo was again in the rectangle.

Upon his return to Aruba RCA was happy to see Mateo join its ranks. Since then, Mateo has kept goal for RCA throughout 8 championship competitions, 7 of which were won by RCA. The one, not won by RCA was played at a time when Mateo was hospitalized.

Our sportin'ality's impressive record as a custodian also includes the following:

Following his trip to Surinam in 1944, he kept goal for the AVB during the Feyenoord series in Curacao in 1945. Taking part in the tournament were Feyenoord (Holland), Curacao, Aruba, Surinam and Colombia.

In 1946 he went along with an RCA — Jong Holland — Holanda combination to Colombia. That same year, in our sister island, he represented Curacao against Diablo Rojo.

In 1947, the Surinamers on the island organized an excursion to Surinam, taking along their football team "Voorwaarts" and "Speen" Linscheer's orchestra. Voorwaarts was re-inforced with some Aruban players and

Mateo was the goal-keeper. Mateo likes to think of this trip as the best he ever had.

He only returned from Surinam to pack his bags again for an RCA trip to Venezuela. In 1948, with

this same team it was "Haiti, here we come".

The following year when 'Sparta', a local Surinam korfbal team travelled to Surinam, Mateo, also an outstanding korfbal player, did not wait to hear the invitation repeated. He had boarded the plane before any other.

In 1949 he represented the AV B in Curacao against the sister-Island, BVV, Colombia and Guatemala, and went to Guatemala with RCA in 1950.

In 1951 he represented SUBT (Cur.) against Guatemala and San Salvador, then went to British Guiana with RCA. That year, our sportin'ality suffered a severe setback as an accident on the job resulted in a partly severed toe, and gradually he made room for other goalies then drawing attention. In between this very busy schedule, Mateo also played football as one of the Lago All Stars, and still found time to practice, play, and become one of the island's highly rated basketball stars, representing Aruba in Colombia in 1946. He is a member of Aruba Jrs. in this branch of sports.

He is also an outstanding korfbal player, and a member of the TOF team with which he travelled to Curacao twice. He's been a member for 8 years.

Then there is softball in which line he played catcher for Aruba Juniors. As a baseball'er he played outfielder and catcher for Pepsi Cola and Nesbitts.

And finally there is table tennis which he "picked up" in the army and in which he represented "Voorwaarts" in Surinam.

Running towards 30, Mateo feels that he is past his prime as a sportsman and is quite satisfied to play ball just to keep in shape. Asked what are his most pleasant memories as a top-flight, he does not

hesitate to say : "My trips to Surinam and British Guiana". Meanwhile, to stick with "balls", Mateo poured himself another highball.

ed to turn in their entry forms, which may be had from members of the Lago's Nursing Staff, as early as possible. Deadline for returning these forms is Wednesday May 6, 1953.

Baby contestants will be divided into 2 age groups, i.e., from one (1) to six (6) months and from six (6) to twelve (12) months old. Three prizes will be available for each age group. The first prize winners, in addition to receiving valuable prizes, will be crowned monarch of that particular group.

All babies will be examined by doctors (specialists) on Friday afternoon, May 8, in the auditorium of the Lago Club. Prize winners will be announced immediately following the examinations, and prizes distributed.

Another attraction will be the Health Poster Contest for youngsters up to eighteen (18) years of age. Again, there will be three prizes available for this contest.

The posters should depict good health practices in relation to children. They should also bear the name, birth date and address of the originator. Posters may be turned in to the Lago Club manager daily, from 12 noon to 10.00 p.m. Deadline date for entries is April 28, 1953. Posters will be on display in the L. H. Club patio during the Health Exhibition on Tuesday afternoon, May 5, 1953.

During the entire health week,

there will be lectures on subjects affecting the health of Aruba's population. These lectures will be held at various points in San Nicolas, Oranjestad and Santa Cruz. Movies will also be shown wherever possible.

These lectures and movies will be free and open to all Aruba, as will be contests.

People who have not had an opportunity to attend last year's Health Week may wonder as to the purpose of this extensive program. The answer is quite simple.

There is nothing so vitally important to a nation as is its health; for upon it depends the entire economy of that nation.. Adults are passing away and their labors can only continue to bear fruit if there are healthy, ambitious, and enterprising youngsters to carry on.

Therefore, the health of its youth deserves special attention at all times.

It is the duty of every community to safeguard the health of its youth. To assist our community in this beautiful but difficult task, the Lago Nurses' Glee Club has taken the initiative and, with the highly appreciated voluntary assistance of the island's best qualified medical men, has set out to enlighten the people by applying the old and ever verdant adage : "A stitch in time saves nine".

It is hoped that, as a duty to the youth of Aruba, all parents and future parents will take advantage of this fine opportunity to attend the highly instructive lectures and by so doing, give the movement their support.

Let the slogan for 1953 be : "Health for our youth".

SOMETHING TO EAT.

This "We would like to get something to eat" was a statement made by several employees to me over the phone, in the latter part of the month of February.

These employees claim that their commissary credits were closed and being working people with their fa-

milies and being out of foodstuff out of their home and no money to buy that they wanted to be able to have their credits opened at least around February 27th, in order that they may be able to feed themselves and their families. I told the employees that I was very much sympathetic with their problem, but it was not under my jurisdiction, since it was a Commissary Advisory Committee problem and I referred them to the C. A. C. I heard later from the Acting Chairman of the C. A. C. that every effort was made to get the Colony

Service to make an exception so that those people "Who wanted something to eat" might be able to do so. It is my understanding that the C.A.C. tried all they could to accomplish the requirements of their constituents but to no avail. The majority of employees feel that this is something that was justifiable and some more serious consideration should have been given the matter.

In matters like these that hurt the employee group, and have a tendency to breed discontentment, the committee should see to it that the Superintendent of Services who is a member of Executive Management has knowledge of the situation instead of allowing the matter to stay put at a low level.

L.S.P. BASEBALL SUBCOMMITTEE REACHES DECISION IN PROTESTED GAME.

Last Friday the Lago Sport Park baseball Subcommittee discussed the protest filed by the baseball team The Local in connection with their competition match played against Seagram's V.O. (Oranje).

The game was protested by The Local on good and valid reasons at a time when this team (The Local) was in the lead 6-2. The game ended with V.O. edging the pressmen 6-7.

The Committee upheld The Local's protest but refused to reverse the victory outright and ruled that the match will be replayed from the time the incident occurred to the end. The score at that time was 6-2 in favor of The Local, with two outs for Seagram's V.O. in the 8th inning.

The previously awarded victory to Seagram's has thus been nullified and the match will be considered incomplete until such time as the re-play has been completed. The score at the end of this re-play will be final.

We have been informed by the Secretary of the Subcommittee that this body had previously reached this decision in the matter. However, at the suggestion of Mr. E. J. Huckleman, Baseball Commissioner and president of the Umpires' Association, the matter was held in abeyance pending a report from the umpires.

Since then, invitations for a discussion were extended to the umpires, but ignored. Considering this and the fact that a decision in the matter is long overdue, the Committee reached a final ruling last Friday.

A word of praise for the Subcommittee's fairness in this matter is in order.

ABBA WHIPS USS RANDALL, READY FOR USS TIDEWATER.

In a fairly exciting game the ABBA boys whipped the crew of the the USS Randall 8-3 at the Wilhelmina Stadium last Saturday night in a friendly match.

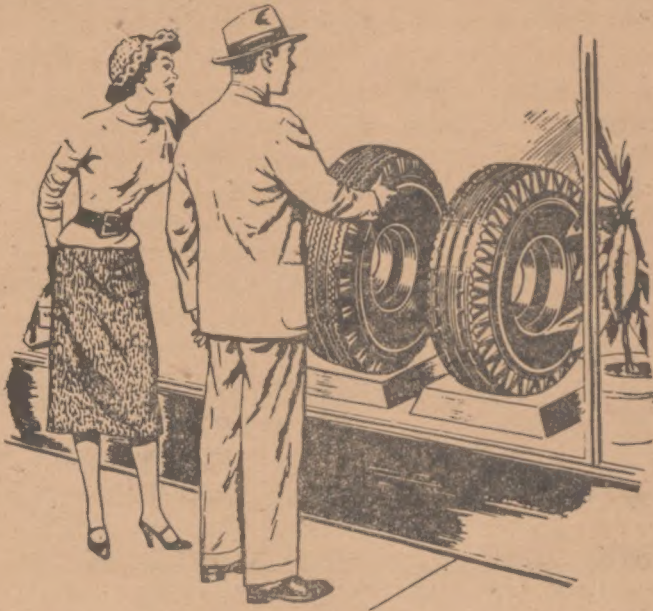

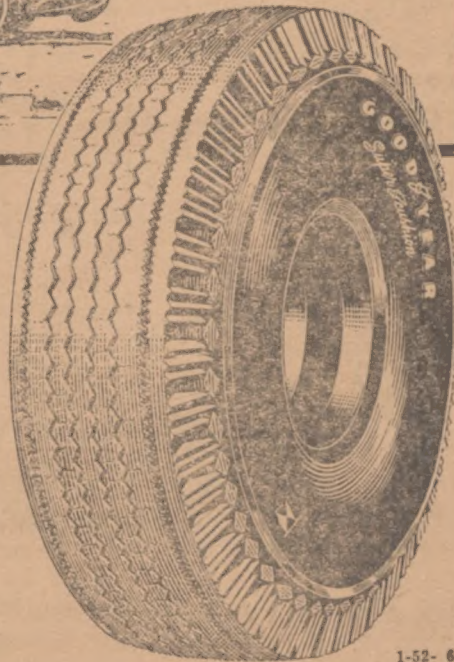

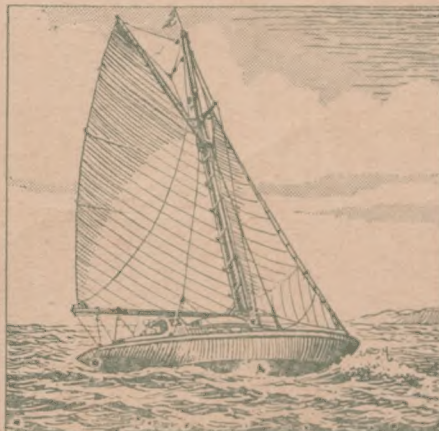
