The Centro Informacion Anti-Droga (CIAD) located in a landmark building on the Oranjestraat is geared to informing and educating youth about the dangers of substance abuse. This not only includes illegal substances, but also alcohol and cigarettes. Ann Angela, the Director of P/R and Information reports that they are very pleased by the response they see amongst Aruba's youth.

The aim of CIAD is to begin educating children from a very young age and in a non-threatening way to resist the attraction of addictive substances. Prizes were awarded in two age categories; four to eight and eight to twelve years. Kimberly Henriquez, ten years old won a portable CD player for her creativity, and Vivan Tromp and Josy Henriquez, both five years old, took home a collection of varied art materials.

The Bugsy slogan was created by ten-year-old Brandon Lassonde, who spends his summers on the island with his Aruban mother, but lives in Canada the rest of the year. He also gave the mascot his name.

The best methods devised so far is the education from an early age in a way that appeals to youngsters of the positive benefits of "staying clean."
