



SETAR, N.V. initiates a special discount plan for Aruba's senior citizens

On Wednesday afternoon, September 14, Roland Croes, Director of SETAR, NV, Aruba's national telecommunications company announced the inauguration of the 60+ Savings Program for the island's pensioners. Now, retirees on a fixed income can receive special discounts on their home phone, cellular service and the installation of DSL broad band internet service.

This program was developed in cooperation with Paul van Niel, the president of OPPA, the Organization of Public Pensioners Arubiano, made up of retired civil service employees. The special discounts will apply to all pensioners, and those that wish to avail themselves of the discount prices need not be a member of OPPA.

Applicants for the SETAR 60+ card should apply for it directly at the SETAR offices in Seroe Blanco, and must bring with them a valid picture ID, proof of legal residency in Aruba, their pensioner's card from the SVB, and a passport picture. The SETAR 60+ discount program will provide a special packet for the home phone for only 15 florins monthly, this will include extra services and caller ID options that will prevent abuse of the home phone. Post paid cell phone accounts can be maintained for only 25 florins per month including 90 minutes gratis, and there is a special discount package on DSL.

Mr. Paul van Niel proudly displayed his specially issued SETAR 60+ card, of which he will receive one that will fit in his wallet, and so can every other pensioner on the island. Roland Croes stated how proud SETAR, NV management is that they have it in their power to assist the Aruba's elderly living on a fixed income, and hopes it sets an example to other island services and vendors,
