

Bingo starts with a bang at the Key Largo Casino!

Bingo is a very popular activity in Aruba, and the Key Largo Casino decided to turn over their tables to this popular pastime every Monday through Friday beginning this week. Hostess Glenda and Sales and Marketing Manager Delia deemed the decision a good one as they saw all the tables filled with happy players when they premiered the new bingo games on Tuesday.

Everyday from the hours of 1:00 to 3:30 PM players have the chance of winning a total of \$1250 dollars (U.S.) in prizes, with a progressive starting at 5000 florins and growing until someone gets a full card in fifty calls or less. The price of \$6 buys a packet for eight games played with four cards. The final jackpot for a full card pays \$400 dollars (U.S.)

The Key Largo Casino next to the La Cabana Villas was filled with both islanders and tourists for the bingo bash, which also includes free drinks. Two of the players, Mark and Wendy from England are seasoned Aruba visitors, and have been on the island for nearly three months this trip.
