I hope you're well. I have attached some photos in hope that something can be done to address this matter.

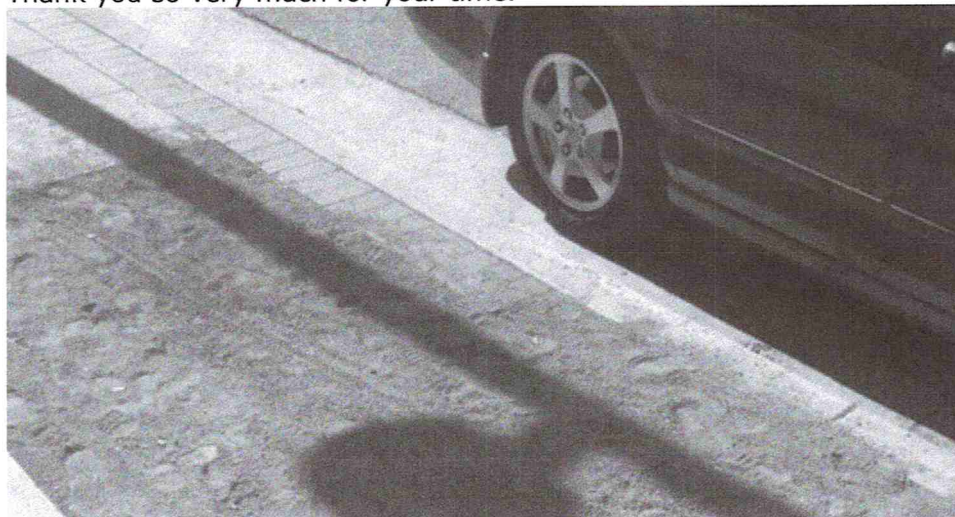
I have passed this along to the powers that be but months have gone by and nothing has been done so I thought I would reach out to you and see if you could help.

Thank you so very much for your time.

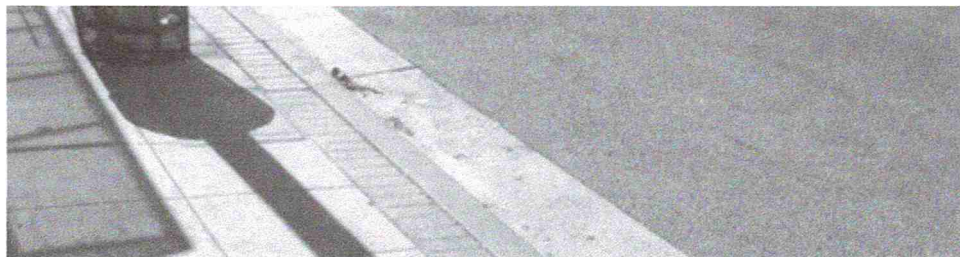
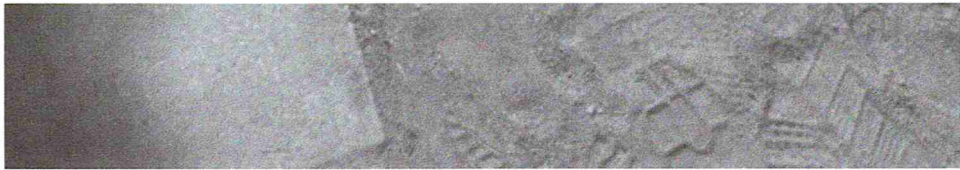


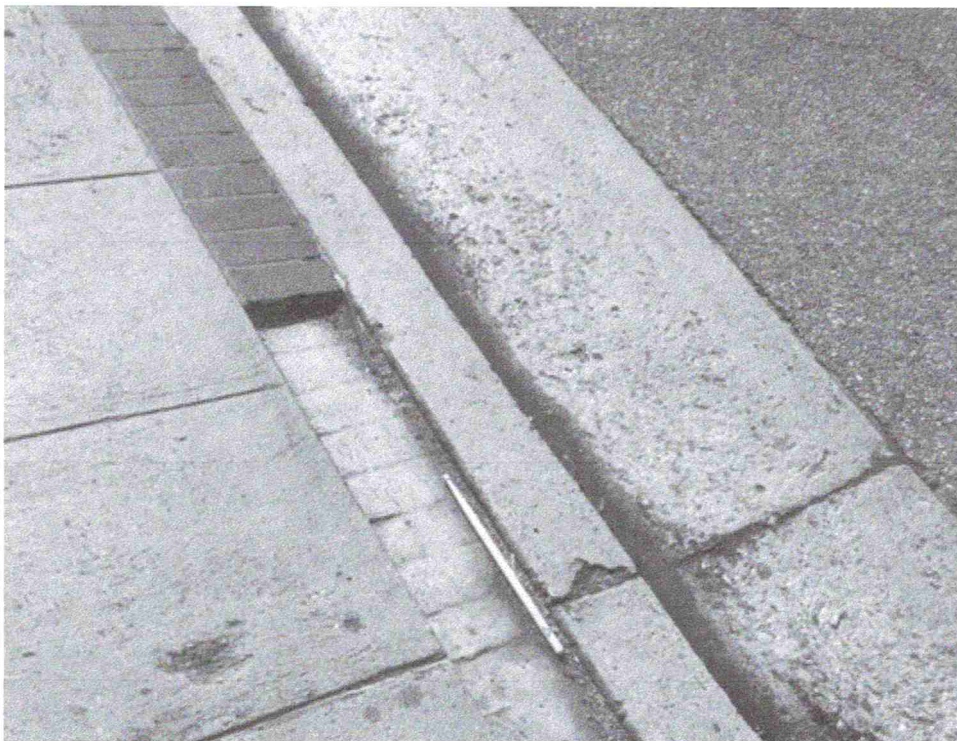


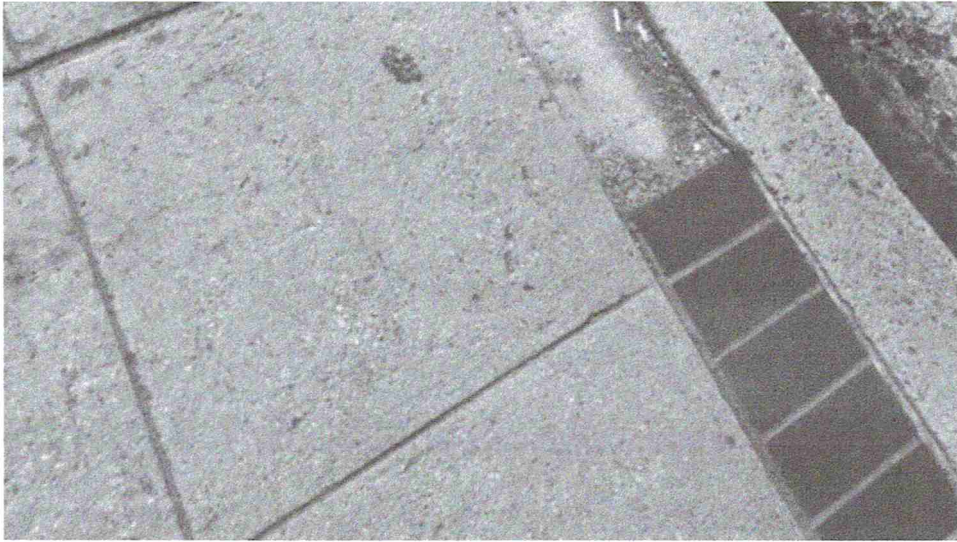
