

After looking last inque at female characters in conventional settings and look at a few different sorts of societies. which could be used to add variety to a campaign world, ea well as giving a few surprises, not to eav shocks, for some of the more complacent players; three types of matharchel society and the "Utopie" of a applety without cender blee. It is large stone of degree in perception and matnarchal societies. In the extreme, and recorded as property rather then ea people, (eq. oncient Sporte), but less extreme societies are likely to be the more common. Often the dominant say rather than evaluitative (an expect of Chrysley), but misogyny (bered of women), or the opposite may still play a part under the surface.

in order to introduce a non-standard society into a world, it is usually decessory to provide some way of isolating that appiety from the rest of the world. Fiction abounds with hidden values mysterious or even floating or flying, islands, and the cest. Any of these would provide e suitable site. Often curely return barriers will be netfertia adequate. Atemptively, what if the players were to discover that their own world' wes just such en isoleted society...? On the other hend, e metherchei society may be strong enough to stand openly amount the other nations, in which case its nature would be known in advance to outsiders. Of course the reports are uplikely to be accurate. . I always find feeding players false ramours (and having them believe there) one of the gleasures of reference.

I make no epology for the fect that these societies have few (but by no means no) bistorical precedents 1 am not a simulationist gamer, but am interested interesting backgrounde for rolegaming. History does provide a useful quide to basic human nature, and to what might work' as a society, but should not be followed slavishly. In a fentasy setting, mage and intelligent non-human races will both effect the nature of the society. opening up many new possibilities.

Another point to bear in mind is that no society should be totally 'one dimensional. Any society should have ourks in its culture, unrelated to the man aspects that mark it out. These could plents, taboos over food or dress and the rest. Also, when playing cheracters born and bred in such societies, remember that they will find their society actual, and others defant. As a celeree, I usually find it height to spend some time thinking evened into a society' before I rup 6, 60 that I know how the people within 4 will

1). The Role Reversel, or Amezon Boclety.

In this type of sporely, women take on oil the traditionally 'male' roles, as solders rules and the rest whist the men export the Temple' roles of child pere end home keeping. Men will be striving to attract women, looking for a protector and provider They'l beautify themselves, and alasses expect woman to take the lead in courtship. Women, on the other hand, edget the 'mell traits' of ecression Mappie Thatchers, in fecti (Of course, TOTAL tole-reversal would only be children. Since this would effectively turn them into women, it would emply result in the standard patriatchel equisity. A sorrewhat pointless exercise?

On the other hand this is perheps the most common type of matriarchal society in fiction and frims (especially pulp fiction) and is the easiest to play. It is elso the least interesting, since it is essentially the same as the patieschel equety, except that the other hell of the consistences in charms. However, such a society can still ove characters enlering from other lands a susprise. You can also male NPCs fit the standard female stereotypes, as well as vice versa. Cheracters from such a society are likely to be hornfied at the surrounding ecclebes. They may well decclise the them so.

2). The All Female Society.

This type of society has obvious problems, the principle one being reproduction. However, in a medic-neth world, & should not be beyond the wrt of the GM to come up with a material method. of reproduction. Such a society will be very eten in feel. Think ebout how much atiracting members of the opposis sec What could take the place of this in such a society? Sociel contacts will be on some other basis than the need to meet the opposite sex. There may be prester creativity due to the loss of env direct Ideneture flourish. Or perhaps society will or on social games (role-playing, perhaps???). For that matter, perhaps the social structure will produce artificial divisions, so that social patherings are designed to bring together Reds and Greene (or whetever), where the actual difference between the dynamous is impossible for an outsider to determine.

coneder. How is eccery organised? Are stable 'merrieges' formed between women? Or is there some different social etructure? Society could be totally communal, with everyone living in large heartha, or it could be totally individualstic, with all members of society living elone other is less likely - everyone needs some human contact!

Are any members of the society, even if last the rulers, aware that men exist elsewhere? What is their attude to men? monsters? Much will depend on the history of the society. If the men were wood out in some disaster, then they might be cemembered with londress, or repetided as purely mythical. On the other hand, a society founded by women who rehelied energy of fied from their men would be likely to have takes of men ea evil monsters. Either way, the image they have of men in likely to be so disjoned by time that they may not even recognise them if they meet them in the first case they would be looking for angels, and in the second, demons. Few male edventurers would it either. Also worth considering is the attitude of these women to women from the outside world. ere seen to be subservent to their menfolk. Carsless schons might epark a of the world ...

Similarly, do the surrounding lands have rumoure of the land in the Mountains", for wherever'? How do the men in the surrounding lands regard thase stones? The women might seam as inhuman and un-natural demons, or as a 'challenge' to their 'mesculate'. They math well seek to ocevent their women learning these stories. How do the women react to the rumours? A possible series of encounters could involve a group of women seeking this supposed Utopia. whist being pursued by their mentals.

It is common in fiction and films for women in such society will eutomatically fall in love with the first men to enter their

land in 'n' hundred years. I'm sorry to disappoint ell those male epos out there, but this is extremely unlikely, not to say diamonal. To women who are used to saving only other women, and who do not associate man with montaction, men would seen like members of a different species. They may be friendly or unfriendly, perheps even 'cute' or interesting, but how many of us would tell in inve with a Gorilla? An interesting, if somewhat controversial, fictional all female society is 'Whilesway', in Joanne Russ' 'The Female Men Whileowey' certainly makes an meresting contrast to the perenous of works like John Wyndham's "Coneider Her Weve"!

The manor image of this is, of course, the of male society. Here we are on firmer ground, as we have more material to draw on. Besides the verious societies in the real world which vistually exclude women from participating in them, we have each institutions as public schools and juntil recently) the screet lotces. Such societies sopeer to be both highly biararchical and connetitive and invertably emphasize military vitues. On the other hend, they could put great emphasis on honour and team-spatt, as woll as asil-relience and achievement. For e truly nightmenish account of such e world, egain see Joenne Russ' "The Female Men", it need not, though, necessarily be any more nightmarish than an all demais society, but the unpleasantness is likely to be of a different neture. perhaps in a lack of compassion or mutual support.

3). The Statue Revereel Society.

This is perhaps the most confusing society for characters from a maledominated one, simply becauss it may sponer on the surface to be a totally conventionel patriarchel society. Men ere seen doing most of the beavy lebourned work, they elso seem to form the matter forces of the society. However, taking to members of this society can be a little disconcerting. The defeut pronous is she' rether then 'he'; the heads of femilies are women, men frequently being referred amply as so end-so's husband e successful scheme or operation may be described as going from 'subtlety to subtlety', rether then 'strength to strength' and warriors command little of no mapect. In contrast, men speak with respect (and sometimes a bills envy) of the terrature skills of child rearing end house keeping. A lew may seek to imitate female dress and mennerisms, and be regarded either os 'getting above themselves', or with a degree of tolerence. Graduely it is notceable that all positions of authority are held by ONCON

To take an example from our own comparism, consider the reliant of Sobhor, one of a smell group of lainnis known as the Eastern take. Solither was the setting them a group of women field a leards. They were led by a great and was soccrease, Anasam Solitholes, and women and children ast up a society in hidro.

Anesse realised that her people needed power if they were to defend themselves once the neighbouring states stopped folting each other. She therefore set sbout treining her people in the arts of sorcery. Other women, and a few men (deserters from both sides), somed them, but men who wished to stay had to accept Agassa believed that the male virtues of physical courage and appression and competition were responsible for the constant warfare in the region. She believed that a better society would be formed if tempioe velues were dominant in it, and she saw subtle maple, cloiomacy and outright cunning as the keys to AUCCESS.

When, many years later, the war finally ended, Sohdhor was already a growing community, with delences based on magic and diplomacy.

Now some 200 years on Sobtbor is a powerful force in the island group It never gets involved in physical combat between the other islands, but her dejornets and spies are ekilled at pisying the islends of ensitiest each other whilst the island itself rememe at peace. The other miends know of the great megical power on the island and Solidhor le keen to remark them of the demost should the feil into the hends of one of the other islands. This has led to the long-standing neace, which is seen by the island's inhabitents (of both sexes) as proof of the superiority of female rule. Why, let men net too much power, and they stort fighting each other. Look at the other stands! Women, who ere the bearers of the next generation, and have greater compassion and gentleness, are clearly better suberi to run things than men Giving birth to and brinding up children are clearly the most importent functions in evolety, and the anddessee have given theas roles to the most importent sex. It is only right that those who care for the next generation should be the ones with the political power to decide what sort of world today's chidren will inhabe. Men are too ready to let their heads rule their heerts, they do not have the understanding of the netural world a women has, for they do not laten to their emotions, only their minds

Warrices, of all types, whether male or female, have low stetus in Sohdhoren life. It is a low status profession, suitable for men. No well born or civilised women

A society such as Sobilitor has merry possibilities for scenerios. For plevers who role play well and are prepared to talk to NPCs setting a concentryely streightlooward search or mystery type scenario within such a society should provide an interesting role-playing experience, with plenty of opportunities for mis-understendings and social gathes. Alternetively the perty could lind themselves being used in a Solidhorien eponeored achiene on some other signd Try to evod using this society purely as a source of villents; there is much that is good in Solichonen ite. Individuale within the society will be as vecied as from etv. other society. For exemple, e man from Solidhor might be hornfied by the levels of violence common in meny standerd fertesy societies, and thus become a fanetical edvocate of female rule!




