MEMORANDUM FOR: COP

SUBJECT: Quintus d'Alquen

1. Attached hereto are three documents which have been submitted by Mr. Roy Morgan. These items all relate in one way or another to the subject individual, whom Morgan describes as the former psychological warfare chief of the Germans. Morgan states that d'Alquen is also known as Borgers or Banars and that he can be contacted through Colonel G.M. Colman, of Region 10, CIC, Bad Kildingen, Germany.

2. The second attachment is a copy of a letter which d'Alquen wanted to have delivered to General Wedemeyer. It was not clear to me whether the original of this letter had ever been sent to General Wedemeyer or not, but Morgan did state that d'Alquen is not personally acquainted with the General.

3. I think it would be worthwhile to have the two documents in the German language translated to English or read by one of your "Deutsche" speakers with a view to ascertaining whether there is anything of interest in this material itself or whether our relations might have any use for the services of d'Alquen either in Germany or elsewhere. It occurs to me that you might want to ask your people in Germany to look into this matter further and advise you on their views.
