Today, the travel agent creates the reservation, writes the ticket and then enters the ticket number into the system for reference. This produces a 7 MAN field in the PNR.		
In order to ensure that the required Date-Of-Birth (DOB) data is entered into the cross border PNR, follow-up action by Amtrak is required in order to obtain the DOB. If '7 MAN' is the ONLY 7Field in the PNR and there is no valid DOB data present, the PNR needs to be queued to the Travel Agency Sales Center's queue 'TEL' (specific number to be determined).		
The following informational header should be placed at the top of the PNR so it appears when the PNR is displayed in queue OR a new queue needs to be labeled as such:		
"CROSS BORDER MANUAL TK - DOB REQUIRED"		
Reason for Change: To handle the situations where travel agencies manually ticket and do not provide required DOB data in the PNR



US Customs Border Protection Agency has also informed Amtrak that all first names must be a minimum of 2 characters.

2. Assumptions

2.1 Functionality

2.1.1 Required information:

Each GDS is required to supply the date of birth and country of citizenship for each passenger in a border-crossing PNR, including infants. The new requirements from the US Customs Border Protection group are to also collect gender and passenger identification.

- PR – LPR (Legal Permanent Resident) Card
- PP – Passport
- RE – Re-entry Permit
- RT – Refugee Travel Document

US Customs Border Protection Agency has also informed Amtrak that all first names must be a minimum of 2 characters. Amtrak will enforce this requirement and reject any Teletype message where the first name of a passenger is less than 2 characters. Amadeus will receive and Acknowledgement notifying them of the reject.

2.1.2 Teletype Element Format

This new element would replace the date of birth OSI. Subject to the approach picked, the data would be placed into the GDS PNR using their system's format for creating the approach (OSI or SSR) picked.

A valid passenger information item will be added to the Arrow PNR, and no response returned. In the case of an error, Arrow will return an advisory message to that effect and that no action has been taken to update the Arrow system. The message will be returned in SSR OTHS elements.

7.1.1 TID6: Process SSR segments

Scan and validate the SSR DOCS item if present in the TTY message. If correct, have the information in it sent to TIG so it can be processed accordingly.

7.1.2 TIG2: Validate key in OSI item

Add 'DOCS' as one of the valid keys for an OSI item. If an OSI DOCS is found, call TIG5 for processing. Verify that condition code is passed to TIG3 as passed from TIG5 in EBX084.

7.1.3 TIG3: Act on result from OSI request

Add an OSI item with error message to the PNR if the request is invalid or not successful (i.e. condition code returned from PD package or TIG5 in EBX084).

7.1.4 TIG5: Process OSI DOCS item

Parse and validate the OSI DOCS item. If correct, build both a dummy 5PID and 5DOB requests with the information provided in the OSI DOCS items and submit them as internal request for processing. Upon completion, pass return condition to calling program thru EBX084.

When processing a border-crossing make sure that valid DOB and PID information is present in the PNR. Call utility RMUX (?) for that verification. In case of error, send canned error message to agent and do not process ticketing request.



7.2.3 TPE3: Worldspan ticketing path

When processing a border-crossing make sure that valid DOB and PID information is present in the PNR. Call utility RMUX (?) for that verification. In case of error, send canned error message to agent and do not process ticketing request.

7.2.4 TOO1: 'PNR now ticketed' process

When processing a border-crossing make sure that valid DOB and PID information is present in the PNR. Call utility RMUX (?) for that verification. In case of error, take existing error path so PNR is queued to TEL/80.

Beginning December 1, 2000 all reservations booked between the United States and Canada in either direction will require the date of birth and country of citizenship for each guest traveling prior to ticketing. The guest must give this information either at the time the reservation is booked or when the ticket is purchased. No guest will be ticketed who has failed to or is unwilling to provide this information.

Guest Documentation Requirements

Guests must be advised that Canadian and U.S. Customs officials require that they have certain documentation with them when leaving or re-entering the country.

INVALID DATE DDMMM
