Information available to Mr. indicated that similar demonstrations would take place in New York and Washington, D.C.



indicated he expected only a few individuals to participate and felt certain that they would not attempt to enter the Consulate.

Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation observed a group of individuals, consisting of both men and women assemble on the sidewalk immediately in front of 215 Market Street at approximately 3:00 p.m. on March 18, 1973. These individuals assumed a sitting position on carpets and blankets they had bought with them. There was no chanting and only three or four posters were in evidence. The area where the demonstrators were seated was separated by a fence from the entrance to 215 Market Street. This fence remained following recent construction work that had been accomplished in the area. One or two individuals placed themselves near the doorway of the building and offered to passers by leaflets.

A typical leaflet among those being distributed appears as follows:

The entire mankind of this universe constitutes one singular people. The whole humanity is bound in fraternity; those who are apt to remain oblivious of this very simple truth . . . those who are prane to distort it . . . are the deadliest enemies of humanity. Today's mankind should identify these foes fully well and build up a healthy human society totally neglecting all obstacles and difficulties.

It must be borne in mind that so long as magnificent, healthy and universalistic human society is not well established, man's culture and civilization, his sacrifice, service, and spiritual endeavor shall not be able to carry any worth whatsoever.

SHRII SHRII ANANDAMURTI Called BABA By His Followers

Spiritual leader and social reformer, has been imprisoned without bail for the last 14 months on charges of murder and conspiracy. In December the murder charges were dropped. The court battle continues... and still bail is denied.

On February 12th, 1973, Shrii Shrii Anandamurti was poisoned in Bankepur Jail, in Patna, India.

Since then, his doctors have not been allowed to see him.

He teaches that we are all children of God and that we are truly one common humanity of brothers and sisters. He teaches that social and economic oppression have no place on our planet.

His crime is that he dared to speak out.

Immediately before his poisoning, Shirii Shirii Anandamurti was isolated from fellow prisoners and from visitors. When he was allowed visitors, he related the incident of the poisoning and requested that he be allowed to see his personal doctor. This was denied, and no care was given.

His pain is severe, his vision blurred. His physical health even before this incident had deteriorated due to the conditions of the Patna jail. He had received neither proper food nor the opportunity for much-needed exercise. His windowless cell was without a fan throughout the summer, at which time the temperature outside rose as high as 130 degrees.

He has not been allowed to be treated by his physician to this date.

He must be hospitalized immediately and must receive proper medical attention if he is to regain his good health.

IN NEED OF MEDICAL ATTENTION

Shrii Shrii Anandamurti's mission is simply one of love of humanity. He asks his followers to look upon every living creature with an attitude of love and sympathy, and realizing the essential unity of all beings to serve mankind as children of one spirit. 

The following was received by mail from National Capitol Parks, National Parks Service, United States Department of Interior, on March 16, 1973:

On March 12, 1973, conducted by the Ananda Marga Yoga Society (AMYS) from 3:00 p.m., March 18, 1973, to 6:00 p.m., March 19, 1973, at Dupont Circle, The purpose of the demonstration was to bring public N.W.. attention to the persecution of Spiritual Leader P. R. Sarkar in India. estimated that five hundred people would participate by the display of fifty placards, fasting and silence except for the singing of one song "We Are One in Snirit". Ten marshals were to be furnished and supervised by Road Hvattsville, and one Maryland, telephone number indicated that b6 he would be and has had one b7C year's experience conducting events for the AMYS.

In filing the above notice. furnished the address of AMYS as 3453 East 12th Street, Wichita, Kansas, 67208, and identified Paul Fahnestock of the same address as president of the Society's National Board.

"The Washington Post Times Hearld" of March 20, 1973, carried a photograph and an article which indicated that thirty-six beople were participating in a twenty-seven hour demonstration in support of their Guru P. R. Sarkar, the founder of the AMYS who had been jailed in India since December. 1971, on a charge of murder. One demonstrator, one ________ advised that similar demonstrations and fasts were being held simultaneously in eight other United States cities and sixteen cities in other countries as well as throughout India.

and Fahnestock, previously mentioned, advised the newspaper representative that Sarkar has a following of twenty thousand people in the United States all of whom have been recruited since the movement was organized in the United States b3 three years ago.

On April 18, 1973, the captioned organization filed a notice of demonstration with the National Capital Parks of the National Park Service of the United States Department of Interior The natice, which was filed by **b6** Street, Ъ7C of the demonstration, indicated that the demonstration would take place on April 23, 1973, commencing at 8:30 a.m. at the Peace Monument at First and Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W. The demonstration would then proceed to Dupont Circle where a vigil would be kept until 2:30 p.m. The demonstration would then proceed to the vicinity of the residence of the Indian Ambassador on Macomb Street, N.W., and then return to Dupont Circle. The stated pur-Tudip pose of the demonstration was to draw/public attention to the persecution in India of a spiritual leader. In literature distributed during the demonstration, the spiritual leader was identified as/Shrii/Shrii/Anandamurti who in previous activities of the/Society had/been iden-tified as the Society's spiritual leader P. R./Sarkar. A representative of the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) advised on April 23, 1973, that the demonstration had proceeded as planned and said that a count had revealed that the participants numbered 287. He said that the demonstrators intended to deliver to the Ъ3 Indian Ambassador the ashes of a monk who had immolated **b6** himself. b7C b7E A representative of the United States Secret Service advised that during the attempt to deliver the ashes at the Indian Embassy, the container of ashes was broken on the Embassy steps and two arrests by the Executive Protective Service ensued on charges of "Depositing Trash in a Public Place." 
On August 17, 1973, a confidential informant who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that the Ananda Marga Yoga Society planned to conduct a three day demonstration in Washington, D. C. (WDC) to protest the inhumane treatment given to Shrii Shrii Anandamurti, who was confined in an Indian prison. The informant stated that the demonstration was to begin on August 17, 1973, at 10:30 a.m. at the Elipse and proceed to the vicinity of the Indian Embassy for a demonstration between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. During the hours of 2:00 to 6:00 p.m., individuals were to demonstrate at the Indian Embassy and the offices of Air India, 1011 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. Four hundred persons were expected to participate in the planned demonstration.

Continuing, the informant advised that on August 18, 1973, the group intended to demonstrate all day in the form of a street theater, a visit to Children's Hospital and a visit to the "RAP Office" at 1417 U Street, N.W.

On August 19, 1973, the group intended to conduct a street theater during the morning hours and to continue their protest on the Elipse during the hours of 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. on that date.

> Shrii Shrii Anandamurti has been publicly identified as the head of the Ananda Marga Yoga Society and has been charged with conspiracy in the slayings of six of his former disciples. He is in prison in India on that charge.

On September 6, 1973, a representative of the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) advised that the reports of that department indicate that between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on August 17, 1973, 80 members

of the Ananda Marga Yoga Society marched from the Elipse to the vicinity of 20th and Q Streets where they protested the jailing of members of the Society in India.



ANANDA MARG

The Ananda Marga Yoga Society is self-described as a group whose members attempt, through self-discipline and meditation, to find ecstasy and inner peace. The Society claims' to have 80 branches in the United States.

The Society has engaged in demonstrations in Washington, D. C., and San Francisco, California, in 1972 and 1973. The demonstrations occurred at the Indian and 1973. Embassy, Indian Consulate, and the White House. The stated purpose of these demonstrations was to protest the jailing of the Society's spiritual leader, Shrii Shrii Anandamurti by the Indian Government in 1971. Anandamurti was arrested by the Indian Government for the murder of six people.

These demonstrations were conducted in a law abiding and peaceful manner; however, a demonstration at the Indian Embassy on April 23, 1973, resulted in the arrest of two demonstrators by the Executive Protective Service for the "Depositing of Trash in a Public Place." The demonstrators were attempting to deliver to the Indian Ambassador the ashes of a monk who had immolated himself. In the process. the container of ashes was dropped and broke on the Embassy steps.

In 1973, the Society published a monthly magazine entitled "Sadvipra." It is not known if this magazine is still being published.







Dr. Veterans Administration Hospital, Building 4-Room C-5, Sepulveda, California, furnished the following information on January 26, 1976:

Dr. ______ who has a PhD degree in the field of pharmacology, visited India in 1974. During her stay there of approximately two months duration she heard of Dr. ______ who was connected with the Bio-Engineering Department of the India Institute of Technology (IIT) in Madras, India, and to whom she was referred in relation to her interest in Oriental meditation. She went to Madras and visited _______ whom she found to be a Hindu in his early forties who was educated in England. _______

Dr. had heard that had a guru who was a "terrorist", that (according to gossip) the bodies of sixteen murdered devotees had been found in his guru's ashram, and that one who belonged to his organization was permitted to leave it alive. When she met he told her "My guru, my swami, is the best; but he's in jail." He indicated the correct number of bodies discovered in his guru's ashram was six not sixteen. (Dr. does not recall the guru's name.)

According to , he was a member of the guru's organization which was named Ananda Margi (or Marga, or Marg'). He invited Dr. to a meeting in his apartment on the IIT campus, at which a guru who was in effect "second in command" of the Ananda Margi was present and during which highpressured members of the IIT staff to join the organization. Ananda Marga

India Sees Threat in Yoga Sect Noted for Good Works in U.S.

By Lewis M. Simons Washington Post Foreign Service NEW DELHI, April 28-To Americans, the Ananda Marga Yoga Society sounds about as harmless as Sgi. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band. American college kids standing on their heads, eating wheat germ, chanting "om, om om."

But in India, Ananda Marga is bearded monks in saffron robes, daggers at their hips, their guru jailed in connection with the murders of six defectors. Here, the government—which Ananda Marga views as corrupt and immoral—regards it in turn as a fascist group committed to ousting the government and installing its own system of highly disciplined regulations.

Ananda Marga means "Path of Bliss." Eight million people throughout the world have been initiated into the group. In India, they run 400 schools, soup kitchens, bring relief to Bangladesh retugees and spirilual succor to the down-

In the United States, followers teach self-respect in black ghettos and in prisons. In Nicaragua, they rebuild houses destroyed by the Managua earthquake, provide food, teach hygiene.

"Violence and dictatorship are the cornerstone of the Ananda Marga philosophy," says India's home minister. Uma Shankar Dixit. "This is an organization which wants to lead the country to fascism."

The basis of Ananda Malga is spiritualism." says Olat Oftedal, a young American devotee. "But the distinction between Ananda Marga and other Indianbased spiritual groups in the United States is that we go beyond mediation and sing-

ing. We try to help oppressed people. We're activists."

Oftedal, 23, came to India last week as a "public relations coordinator" working for the release of the founder and head of Ananda Marga, Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar, known to his followers as 'rii Shrii Anandamurti.

NCLOSUXA

Anandamulti. "Bliss personified." a Soycar-old former railway accounts clerk, founded Ananda Marga in 1955. He has been imprisoned since Dec. 29, 1971, on iconspiracy charges in the playings of six of his former disciples.

Sarkar was arrested in the eastern state of Bihar after wife several his and other followers went to the police. In addition to charging him with the murders, Mrs. Sarkar said her husband engaged in "bizarre" practices, including forcing -his followers into homosexual acts" after convincing "hem they had been women their former lives.

"We have no doubt, that she eventually will deny her public statements, says Oftedal. "She was coerced. She signed statements in English, and she doesn't understand English."

b3 b6 57C b7E Sarkar, however, speaks English. 20 Indian tongues and several other languages, including Norwegian, says Oftedal. The blond-haired American devotee is the son of a Norwegian diplomat,

- formerly an ambassador to Canada, and an American mother.
- .' He says most of the 20,000 members of the U.S. branch, which has its headquarters in Wichita, Kan., are white, clean-cut, middle-class and college-educated, like himself.

"I graduated from Harvard summa cum laude," Oftedal says, "But I and the Harvard intellectuals I know are nothing in comparison with Baba.

Baba, an affectionate term meaning "Papa," is "a giant of intelligence, morality and strength," he says.

"Baba is the incarnation of God," a bearded monk screamed earlier this week, his curly black hair streaming down the back of his saf-"on costume. "Baba alone is

On the high platform in front of the crowd was a small earthenware pot, said to contain the ashes of a monk who had burned himself to death earlier 'this month out of frustration over Sarkar's detention.

Rudrananda Avadhut, a tall, handsome monk wearing blue-tinted glasses, told the crowd that another immolation was imminent.

Breaking into an English translation of his speech, for the benefit of foreign correspondents, he said that a registered letter had been sent earlier in the day to Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and President V.V. Giri, warning that If they would not meet with Ananda Marga representatives tragedy would follow. Neither the prime minister nor the president responded. The immolation took place the next day inside an ancient stone fort. It was catried out suddenly and in secrecy from the police, but net from the news media.

News coverage is extremely important to Ananda Marga. Oftedal and his Indian public relations counterpart, Acharya Nirmohananda, carry briefcases erammed with press handouts, background informa-, tion, and clippings.

Before last week's demonconcluded. it stration evolved into what Indianspast masters of every form of protest- term "courting" arrest." A few hundred demonstrators with paper swastika emblems pinned to their shirts broke police cordons around the meeting ground and were shoved into waiting vans. But not before the police discharged tear gas cylinders and cracked some heads with bamboo staves.

*Look, look. You gentlemen of the press have seen the police brutality," cried Nirmohananda. "You, 'Mr. Lal, you have seen their vi-. cious, maddog attacks. Tell the world how we are persecuted."

The next day, Tuesday, Surender M. Lal, a Columbia Broadcasting System, cameraman, tried to tell the, world. Accompanied by Patricia Duregne de Launaguet, .a young French woman who works as a sound technician, Lal filmed the immolation. Lal's film and some still pictures taken by a photographer hired by Ananda Marga are the only complete records of the burning.

"The police moved swiftly. They immediately arrested two monks present at the immocation and charged Them with criminal conspiracy. Lal and Miss de Launaguet were arrested that night at Bombay airport, where they had fled from Delhi. They were charged with conspiracy. The police seized a roll of 16-mm, color film from Lal. Whether it is the film of the immolation will not be known until it is. processed, something which cannot be done in India.

Tucsday night and Wednesday, the police staged raids at Ananda Marga's New Delhi headquarters and elsewhere. They arrested 24 monks and other persons, including a physician connected with the group.

The physician, Dr. Subash

Rana, is one of a large number of middle-class and wealthy Indians who are attracted to Ananda Marga's potently anti-Communist philosophy. The organization has also drawn a high proportion of senior government officials, enough to cause the government to attempt outlawing Ananda Marga and, failing that, banning membership for civil servants.

Rumors are circulated widely in Delhi that officials with access to government funds have helped finance Ananda Marga. According to the organization, financing comes from assessment of members—they must donate two per cent of their income—and "private contributions."

Friday in Parliament, a member of the ruling Congress party claimed that the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency was behind the organization. The charge was carried on the front page of The Patriot, a daily newspaper published by the Communist Party of India. 'ANANDA' MARGA

Certainly the group is well-heeled. Located behind the New Delhi headquarters is the Ananda Press Plant, a printing firm owned by the organization. Another press is operated in Patna, Bihar, the group's headquarters. According to Oftedal, Ananda Marga owns "dozens" of other printing plants throughout India.

"We believe that literacy and information are important in educating the lower classes about the corruption and immorality of the Indian government," he said. The presses churn out dozens, if not hundreds, of different Icatlets, circulars, pamphlets and newspapers. At the moment, most of them stress the alleged persecution of Sarkar and the claim that Indian Intelligence officers poisoned him in his jail cell. According to several of these publications, Sarkar has been so maltreatedconfined to a cell without so much as a fan in 130 degrees temperatures, fed rotten food and deprived of medical attention-that he has been forced to go on a fast as a last resort. He reportedly has not eaten since the beginning of this month.

Just as the Communist and Congress Parties, which have operated as allies the last few years, are leading the current attacks on Ananda Marga, its greatest support comes from the right-wing, pro-Hindu Jana Sangh Party.

In the last few days, several 'government officials have drawn comparisons between Ananda Marga and Jana Sangh's parent organization, Rashiriya Swayamsevak Sangh (National Self-Service Organization). RSS, as it is widely known, was founded some 25 years ago, around the time India won - "10.4

its independence from Britain. It is a broad-based, tightly disciplined Nazistyle organization which drills its uniformed university student members in self defense and the use of weapons.

A founder of both Jana Sangh and RSS, Shyama Prasad Mukherjee, died in 1951 in a Kashmir prison where, his followers claimed, he was poisoned to death.

Ananda Marga, according to Home Minister Dixit, is "much worse than RRS."

How bad is it? Even if it has 250,000 members in India — which it claims; but -which is most unlikely does it constitute a threat to the government? The answers, given by both the government and Ananda Marga, are yes and no.

The organization espouses a philosophy of "socio-economico-politico-religious revolution" which it calls the progressive utilization theory or Prout. The so-called Proutist bloc has run candidates for the Contral and Bihar state governments and at one time had a single member of Parliament.

Ananda Marga literature admits that much of Sar kar's teachings are "unfathomable" and that they require, at least, "a sustained effort and a highly developed intellect."

'Nevertheless, in trying to capsulize Prout for the ordinary man, one pamphlet says "it stands for guaranteeing minimum essentials of life to each and every individual. The essentials should, go on increasing

progressively with growing economy and growing wealth."

According to a New Delhi newspaperman, who is active in Ananda Marga, the theory is of immediate importance and applicability to India, "where the government is widely known to be corrupt and immoral and is actively courting the Communists."

Oftedal adds that it is also of immediate use in certain countries of Latin America and in the Philippines, where Ananda Marga claims to be particularly active. (A group spokesman in Manila said Friday that a "sacrificial death" by immolation was planned there.) Prout is not applicable, at this moment, in the United States," Offedal says. In a 35-page appeal to Amnesty International, the group said, "clearly, the CBI (Central Bureau 10. Investigation) and the government seem to be haunted by the fear of being thrown out of power by the rapidly rising moral and spiritual force" of Sarkar and Ananda Marga.

"Nonsense," says Minister of State for Home Affairs Ram Nivas Mirdha. "They are merely a gang of extremists and criminals and that is the way we are treating them. Sarkar is being treated the same as any other person charged with a murder conspiracy charge. No worse and no better."

For every Ananda Marga claim of pressure tactics, persecution, illegal detention and maltreatment, Mirdha has a logical and legal argument;


"The pressure they are feeling is because they are at loose ends without their leader. This shows how much of a dictator he is. His word is law to them.

"We are certainly not persecuting them. We classify them somewhere between a crank case and dangerous criminals. But we do not worry unduly about them.

"Sarkar is not being detained illegally. A magistrate has committed the case to the Bihar sessions court. The group has been allowed an extraordinary appeal to the Federal Supreme Court. This is pending. Bail has not been allowed because the Bihar court fears Sarkar will tamper with the evidence."

Maltreatment? Mirdha referred to a statement made by the Bihar government after Sarkar claimed he was poisoned on Feb. 12. The government said he was examined by a state physician and a cardiologist who found only that his blood pressure was "a little high" and that a claim of blindness turned out to be conjunctivitis. * "for which drops and ointment were prescribed."

Yet, despite this cool logic, the answers do not quite reply to the questions. A foreign journalist who asked Mirdha if he could be given permission to visit Sarkar in jail was refused. "It is against the regulations" he said.



"ostensible object of propagating Yoga and "Anand Marg" philosophy. <u>Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar</u>, the founder of the Ananda Marga, is also known as "<u>BABA</u>" or "ANANDA MURTHIJI". He claims to be the incarnation of God, and his purpose is to establish a government of "moralists". He succeeded in persuading his followers to believe that he had supernatural powers and could liberate their souls.

2. Once the Anand Marg gained some popularity, it started dabbling in politics and advocated dictatorship of moralists which was to be achieved through violent means. One of its wings known as the Proutist Block of India (PBI), was registered with the Elections Commissioner. The organisation started a para-military cadre to give training in military drill, guerilla warfare etc., to its members. (X)

3. Secrecy and absolute loyalty are the most important features of the Ananda Marg movement. All those members who defected were declared enemies and their liquidation was ordered-by "Baba". For this purpose a "Killer Squad" was formed. In March 1967, five such exfollowers were killed in the presence of P. R. Sarkar himself. In subsequent years also a number of dead bodies of ex-members were discovered. The investigations revealed that all the murders were ordered by the Anand Marg leader, P. R. Sarkar. Accordingly, in December 1971, Sarkar was arrested and he is being tried by the Indian courts.

"4. Since 1968, Anand Marg started opening its branches in different countries in the guise of Yoga Societies, pre-school programmes and relief centres. Some of the foreign disciples were taken to India for indoctrination The Anand Marg set its foot in the USA in 1971 when Acharya Yatishwaranande Avadhoot (alias) R. Wenkatanarayan was sent to propagate Ananda Marga's philosophy. Acharya Yatishwarananda established his headquarters at Wichita, Kansas State and registered the Ananda Marga Yoga Society of USA as a non-profit, non-religious organisation in the same year. 5. Since its inception in USA, the Ananda Margis by Ach. Yatishwarananda are constantly engaged in anti-Indian propaganda. They have been agitating against the arrest of their spiritual leader P. R. Sarkar and have been asserting that he had been detained on illegal and false grounds with the object of suppressing the spiritual and social philosophy propagated by him. In March 1973, the American followers of the Ananda Marg organised a day long vigil in front of the United Nations and submitted a petition to the Secretary-General requesting him to exert his influence on the Government of India for the release of their leader, P. R. Sarkar. Similar vigils were maintained in front of the Indian Consulate, New York, and the Indian Embassy in Washington. They also approached other organisations such as the International League for the Rights of Man (USA), the Amnesty International and even some Senators to seek help for Sarkar's release without any trial. For this purpose, they also set up various cells such as "International Committee to obtain justice for Shri Shri Ananda Murthiji", "Baba's Release Committee", "P. R. Sarkar International Defence Committee" etc.

⁶. In June 1975, the Ananda Marga was banned in India. This made the followers of the Ananda Marg more bitter and violent against the Government of India. In August 1975, they again organised a protest rally in front of the Indian Embassy, Washington, and in front of the United Nations and it is learnt that they are now planning to organise vigils in front of the building occupied by the Indian Mission to the UN and the Indian Consulate General during August 1976 to protest against the prolonged detention of their leader.





