Entertainment takes the stage

Antioch theater opens season with award-winning play

ANTIOCH - In an ever-evolving world, certainty can be hard to come by. In their newest production, members of PM&L Theatre are out to cast even more doubts on situations that may otherwise appear to have simple answers.

Located in downtown Antioch, PM&L Theatre opened its 48th season this month with a production of "Doubt: A Parable" under the direction of Charles Lindas. The fourmember cast hopes the audience leaves with more questions than an-

"If you end tonight and everyone agrees with what happened, then [we] didn't do something right," said east member Ruth Albrecht. Albrecht plays Sister James, a young and ambitious nun teaching at a Catholic school that is rife with con-

"None of us have actually discussed what actually happened [at the end]," Albrecht said. "The uncertainty fuels us every night."

"Doubt" is a Tony Award- and Pulitzer Prize-winning drama written by John Patrick Shanley. The play is set in 1964 where St. Nicholas Catholic School is the first to enroll a black If you go ...

child. Albrecht plays the child's teacher, but she is forced to deal with the demands of Sister Aloysius - played by Chris Heilgeist - a principle for whom discipline and order are paramount.

When the order that Sister Aloysius values so highly is thrown out of balance, the characters, as well as the audience, are left full of doubt and hard questions about the right course of action. The lack of order revolves around Father Flynn - played by L. Stephen Phelan – who rarely sees eye to eye with Sister Aloysius. Renee Johnson completes the cast with her role as Mrs. Muller, the lone black child's mother.

Assistant Director Reggie Reynolds believes the lack of a clear resolution is what makes this production so attractive.

"I would like [the audience] to understand that life is a dialogue. You can't go away knowing it's this way or that. There is always more to the story," Reynolds said.

Reynolds said rehearsals for the production began the second week of August, leaving only five weeks before opening night. The limited preparation time did not dissuade

"It's unusual to have a group like this gel as fast as we did," Heilgeist said.

"Most of the work was with the actors to do the lines," Reynolds said. "The set is so simple yet rich. It tells you exactly what you need to know.

The production runs through

Sunday, Sept. 28, and tickets are still available for all remaining shows. Reynolds encourages people to call ahead for reservations. Phelan believes the audience will

leave with plenty to discuss on the ride home. 'It's a fun show to talk about at the end," Phelan said. "[The ending]



State board to review plan

LINDENHURST - Plans to build a new hospital in Lindenhurst are inching closer to reality.

The Illinois Health Facilities Planning Board voted unanimously Sept. 17 to review modified hospital plans from Vista Health Systems.

The board will review the

At the September meeting, Barbara Martin, president and chief operating officer of Vista Health System, outlined Vista's modified plans that call for a smaller, less costly hospital. The new plans address earlier questions from the state board.

State statistics show that while there is one hospital bed for every 360 residents in Illinois, in Lake County there is one authorized bed for every 2,462 residents.

Martin said in a news release that Vista's plans for a hospital in Lindenhurst would help ensure healthcare access to Lake County residents.

"Whether looking at Illinois, the United States, other industrialized countries, or even some emerging nations, this ratio appears to be low. In a nutshell, we believe this is compelling evidence of mal-distribution of hospital beds in the planning area," Martin said.

The number of beds at the proposed hospital has yet to be determined, but the number is expected to be somewhere between the 100 in the modified proposal and the 140 beds originally proposed, officials said.

The site for the proposed höspital is on the corner of Grand Avenue and Deep Lake Road in Lindenhurst.


Scardina encourages customers to ask for special orders if they do not find the exact model they are searching for.

In the future, Kelly wants to expand the program to teachers.



Dorn is a 19-year veteran of the NSSD and has served as the district's general manager since May 2005.









County sheriff unloads political bombshells

Sheriff Mark Curran, after almost two years of relative political obscurity as the Democrat who took control after many years of GOP dominance, recently fired a couple of bombshells.

First, he made national headlines by being booked and fingerprinted before spending a week behind bars - in the county jail.

Curran said he volunteered to find out about the life of inmates and what programs are best suited to reduce recidivism rates.

Well known for his strong faith, Curran said the corrections system, in general, restricts worship, and he believes faith-based programs can help inmates become rehabilitated.

He said it is difficult to reduce recidivism when jail conditions contribute toward hardening criminals.

Just the announcement that he would jail himself

brought many comments, some politically motivated, that Curran was pulling off a "publicity stunt."

Curran doesn't run for re-election for another two vears, so there can't be any gain for jailing himself.

The second "bombshell" was Curran's endorsement of Republican incumbent Michael Waller as state's attorney. That decision caused havoc among the local Dems and sealed Curran's reputation as a political maverick.

It may not be a phenomenon when a public official votes for or gives quiet support for a candidate from the opposing party. It was strongly rumored that Waller had "spread some good words on behalf of Curran in the 2006 election.

Waller knew Curranwhen hè served as an assistant state's attorney. But, to make an official endorsement, now, that's rare.

No one was madder than . former Democratic Vice Chairman Peter Couvall.

As I recall, it was Couvall who suggested that Curran run for sheriff, and no one worked harder to get him elected. So, for him, and other party loyalists, it was a bitter pill to swallow.

The endorsement will do little to affect the outcome of the state's attorney election.

Mike Waller will win. For Curran, the endorsement won't hurt him a bit. Unless something unforeseen happens in the management of the sheriff's office, I believe that Mark Curran will win re-election more

overwhelmingly in 2010. And he will win as a Democrat. The only thing that could change that would be If Curran chose to run for higher office.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CALL FOR A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

That will be submitted to the voters - November 4, 2008 To the Electors of the State of Illinois:

At the general election to be held on Tuesday the 4th day of November, 2008, you will be called upon in your sovereign capacity as citizens to adopt or reject the calling of a constitutional convention for the State of Illinois.

The 1970 Illinois Constitution requires the electors of the State to decide, every 20 years, if it is necessary to revise or rewrite the Illinois Constitution. In 1988 the electors rejected the call for a constitutional convention, with 75% voting against and 25% voting in favor of convening a convention. At the general election to be held on November 4, 2008, the voters will be called upon to decide whether Illinois should convene a constitutional convention

EXPLANATION

The purpose of a state constitution is to establish a structure for government and laws. The Illinois Constitution provides citizens with rights and protections; creates the executive, judicial, and legislative branches of government; clarifies the powers given to local governments; limits the taxing power of the State; and imposes certain restrictions on the use of taxpayer dollars. There are three ways to initiate change to the Illinois Constitution: (1) a constitutional convention may propose changes to any part; (2) the General Assembly may propose changes to any part; or (3) the people of the State by referendum may propose changes to the Legislative Article. Regardless of the method of initiating change, the people of Illinois must approve any changes to the Constitution before they become effective.

A constitutional convention is a meeting of delegates elected by the people to review the Constitution. During a convention, the delegates may propose changes to parts of the current Constitution, write a new Constitution, or make no changes hatsoever. If the people of the State on November 4, 2008 decide it is necessary to call a convention, a separate election will be held to elect delegates to represent the voters during the constitutional convention. The elected delegates will meet to review the current constitution and decide whether the constitution should be revised or rewritten. There is no limit as to how long a constitutional convention may meet. The last constitutional convention met for nine months. Once the delegates complete their work, the voters will have an opportunity to approve or reject proposed changes.

The call for a constitutional convention will be on the November 4, 2008 general election ballot. Voters that believe the 1970 Illinois Constitution should be reviewed, revised, or rewritten through the convention process should vote "YES" on the question of ealling a constitutional convention. Three-fifths of those voting on the question or a majority of those voting in the election must vote "yes" in order for a constitutional convention to be called. Voters that believe that a constitutional convention is not necessary, or that changes can be accomplished through other means, should vote "NO" on the calling of a constitutional convention.

The constitutional convention proposal will appear upon the ballot in the following form:

Proposed call for a Constitutional Convention Explanation of Proposed Call

This proposal deals with a call for a state constitutional convention. The last such convention was held in 1969-70, and a new Constitution was adopted in 1970. The 1970 Illinois Constitution requires that the question of ealling a convention be placed before the voters every 20 years. In 1988 the electors rejected the call for a constitutional convention, with 75% voting against calling a convention and 25% voting in favor of calling a convention. If you believe the 1970 Illinois Constitution teeds to be revised through the convention process, vote "YES" on the question of calling a constitutional convention. If you believe that a constitutional convention is not necessary, or that changes can be accomplished through other means, vote "NO" on the calling of a constitutional convention.

I look at my five kids sometimes and see prepackaged, predetermined little people I'm simply watching over for

At times, I feel like I'm just someone they stop to ask for directions before heading onto their next destination. And lately, my 2-1/2-year-old twin daughters would rather take another route or simply not stop. Unless, of course, something's in it for them, such as a popsicle.

I'm convinced each of my kids came to me ingrained with certain personality traits I simply must accept.

To fight them is like trying to stretch a sheet over a mattress while someone sits on it. Which brings me to my 2-1/2-year-old daughter Anna.

"Stop!" I scream down the block during a "leisurely" bike ride with my kids. "I said

Now, I know Anna can hear me. The neighbors three blocks down can hear me. The people in the plane flying overhead can hear me.

But she pedals faster.
I reach her, explain to her like I have, oh, I don't know, every day since the kid learned to walk, that she, "must

listen!"
Meanwhile, her twin sister
Lilly, is yelling, "Stop, Anna"
along with me. She'd rather sit
in the stroller holding a cup
full of rocks that she gathered
in the backyard, her "collection"

But, for the love of God, don't ever take that collection away from her. You'll hear about it for at least the next two hours. She WILL NOT LET IT GO.

As Lilly's temper tests my patience, Anna tests the limits of my sanity.

She's up at 5 a.m. to tell me that her back itches or that she can't find the blanky she's holding or that she'd like to go outside and wait for the school bus. The bus that her big sister won't be getting on until nearly three hours later.

She's the one playing in the toilet or dumping an entire container of fish food into the bowl because the fish was "hungry."


She knows not to go in the road when we're all playing outside. But she'll go to the edge of the driveway, turn to look at me and then slowly place one foot in the road.

"If someone's laughing, crying or screaming, Anna's involved," my mother told me. "You're probably not going to change her. And really, you don't want to change her."

She's right, Of course, I'll keep disciplining all of my children. I'll teach them right from wrong. But I wouldn't want to take away Anna's spunk or Lilly's determination. Instead, I have to tell myself, "That's who they are, love it or not."

For many children, growing pains aren't a myth

For many kids, it's a pain to grow up.

The phrase "growing pains" might bring to mind Kirk Cameron with a mullet, at least for those who grew up during the 1980s when a sitcom of the same name was popular.

But it's actually used to describe what some doctors call a medical mys-

Growing pains, mostly in the legs, occur in up to 40 percent of all children, according to some estimates. Yet the exact cause remains unknown.

They can strike any time between the ages of 2 to 12, but mainly peak at ages 3 to 5 and 8 to 12.

"There's no consensus about the exact definition," said Dr. Dana Hartwigsen, a doctor of osteopathic medicine at Centegra Health System. "I don't think any kids necessarily have them the same way."

That's likely why they often go undi-

They most often occur at night, either at bedtime or during the middle of night after a child has been quite active during the day or awake for a long time, Hartwigsen said.

Some children might experience them and their parents never really know. Others, such as 8-year-old Alex Rav"They would wake up in the middle of the night from the pain crying like crazy. Luckily, it doesn't happen that often, but when it does, it's usually a sleepless night."

Sherry Ravagnie, Huntley mom whose sons suffer from growing pains

agnie and his 5-year-old brother, Arik, don't suffer quietly.

"They would wake up in the middle of the night from the pain crying like crazy," said their mother, Sherry Ravagnie, of Huntley. "Luckily, it doesn't happen that often, but when it does, it's usually a sleepless night."

Sherry said her husband knew immediately the boys were experiencing growing pains because he remembered going through them as a child.

The boys still get the pain, usually occurring every several months or so, she said.

Their mother usually tries to rub their legs to help them fall back asleep.

Along with massage, doctors suggest heating pads and pain relievers, such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen.

Though some physicians believe the pains actually are caused by growth, others say that's not necessarily the case.

Hartwigsen said she read that the pains are more influenced by the activities of the child than growth spurts, and only occur in up to 10 percent of children. Girls get them slightly more than boys, she said.

They tend to be intermittent, occurring off and on for multiple months in a row, she said.

"The big thing is the child should not have any other symptoms with it," she said.

If the child also has weight loss, fever or swollen or red legs or becomes more tired than usual, it's probably not growing pains, she said.


If any pains keep occurring, it's best to have the child checked by a doctor, she said.

Growing pains tend to occur out-

side the joints of the legs, in the shins, thighs, calves and behind the knees.

Less often, they can affect the feet or upper extremities; according to Dr. Jack Maypole, a pediatrician and assistant professor of pediatrics at Boston University, who has studied and written about the topic for Wondertime parenting magazine.

He estimated as many as 40 percent of children get the pains, adding that children often get the pains at night.



• Stretching or leg rubs before bed and after periods of intense activity might help.

• If the child also has weight loss, fever or swollen or red legs or becomes more tired than usual, it's probably not growing pains. See your doctor. Help the child think happy thoughts, and work

through the pain with mental positivity.
• Remember, the pain usually resolves itself.

In its research into "competitive foods" in schools, those that fall outside the realm of cafeteria foods regulated by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the prestigious Institute of Medicine reports that 98 percent of high schools have vending machines, school stores or snack bars that sell junk food. Many elementary schools also have similar purchase opportunities for unipealthy snacks. And it's obvious that students are purchasing and consuming these snacks. According to research, approximately \$2.2 billion was spent on junk food at, schools nationwide in 2003-2004

Fattening Foods Have Health Implications

Health experts believe that, in response to increasing obesityrates among the country's youth, these unhealthy snacks need to be removed from school grounds and replaced with healthier options. Childhood obesity can lead to longterm health concerns, such as diabetes and cardiovascular problems later in life. And the ban would not be limited to food alone; beverages would also have to pass muster.

Some schools have already implemented their own vending machine makeovers without the need for legislation. Certain food manufacturers have also joined in the process to offer healthy alternatives for students. For example, a few years ago in Connecticut, healthy vending machines subsidized by Stonyfield Farm became part of Connecticut Team Nutrition's healthy snack pilot project, aimed at developing a state model for pro-

viding healthy snack choices. "Let's face it, when it comes to preventing childhood obesity, food businesses like mine can either be part of the problem or part of the solution," says Gary Hirshberg, Stonyfield Farm CEO and father of three. "Twenty years in the yogurt business has taught me that if students are offered great-tasting, healthy alternatives, they will make the right decision."

1. Elect a panel of students who will help choose news products for vending machines. Or, organize a school-wide taste test and narrow down four or five new items.
