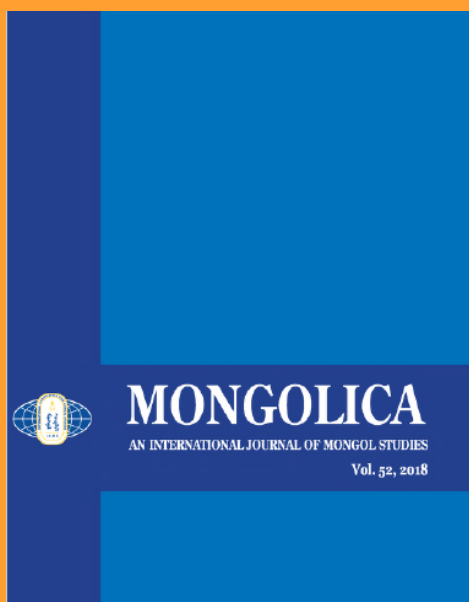

An international scholarly conference "Phagpa Script – 750" was held under the auspices of the President of Mongolia, co-sponsored by the School of Science of the Mongolian State University, Gandan Tegchenling Monastery the Centre of Mongolian Buddhists, the Institute of Language and Literature of the

Mongolian Academy of Sciences, National Library of Mongolia and the Pagpa Foundation. The conference was held at the State University Library, where the scholars and researchers presented 19 papers concerning monuments of the Phagpa Script, its usage and the issues and challenges in promoting this Script.

Microbes on the move: Dairying Diversity on the Eurasian Steppes

18-28 MAY, 2019 ULAANBAATAR



'Microbes on the Move' academic conference to be organized in Ulaanbaatar and Bishkek during May 18-28 under the 'Dairy cultures' research project of the Max Planck Institute for the Science of Human History.

'Dairy cultures' investigates the unique biological and cultural relationships between humans, livestock and microbes with aims to expand the the public's understanding about dairy products. The project is focused on Mongolia's ancient and modern culture of dairying, traditional technologies and experiences.

Within the framework of the project, a travelling conference themed 'Microbes on the Move- Dairying Diversity and Food Sovereignty on the Eurasian Steppes' was organized in Ulaanbaatar on May 18-22 and Bishkek on May 23-28. In addition to the scholars and researcher of dairy industry, herders and dairy producers of Mongolia and Kyrgyzstan gathered at the conference to discuss the historical and archaeological aspects of dairying in Eurasian Steppes and modern tendencies of dairy production and farming.

A project called “Inheriting and sustaining the traditional folk long song performance technique of Limbe (flute) performances – circular breathing” is planned to be implemented from 2019-2021 by the National Cultural Heritage Centre under the Mongolian Ministry of Education, Culture, Science and Sports with support from UNESCO’s Intangible Cultural Heritage Foundation. The project was launched in Ulaanbaatar on 21 May jointly by the Mongolian National UNESCO Commission and a local NGO - the Association of Mongolian Flutists. The key objective of the projects is to further consolidate the joint efforts of the Government of Mongolia, the Mongolian Ministry of Education, Culture, Science and Sports, the National Cultural Heritage Centre and other governmental and non-governmental organisations to promote the inheritance and sustaining of the traditional folk long song performance

technique of Limbe performances - circularbreathing, which was registered inscribed in 2011 on the List of Intangible Cultural Heritage in Need of Urgent Safeguarding, stepping up the research into this technique, promoting and celebrating the continuers of this tradition, and disseminating it among the younger generation, thus ensuring the sustainable continuation of this heritage. It is planned, within the framework of the project, to conduct a field survey to register and document the continuers of this traditional technique and to set up Limbe-flute teaching and learning studios at the National Cultural Heritage Centre, the University of Culture and Arts, and the Music and Dance Conservatory in Ulaanbaatar as well as in Khovd, Zavkhan and Ömnögobi aimags. It is also planned to develop an instructor handbook with DVD and to organize teacher-student trainings in the western, eastern and central regions of the country.

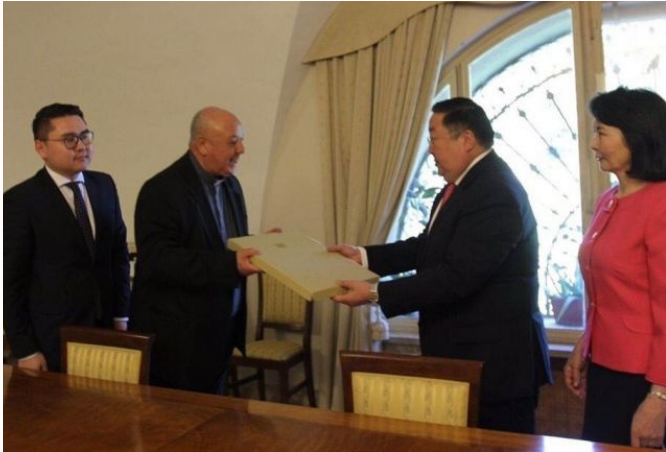


University took part in the Vienna conference discussing papers on the role and special nature of religion in the history of Mongolia.

Letters' copies of Mongol khans to Popes handed over to Mongolian side

20 MAY, 2019, VATICAN

Bishop Sergio Pagano, Prefect of the Vatican Secret Archives, handed over to the Ambassador of Mongolia to Italy Ts.Jambaldorj the copies of eight 13th



century letters of khans of the Ilkhanate to the Popes. As a result of the relentless efforts by the Ambassador Ts. Jambaldorj and the Embassy officials over the past two years historical documents related to the Mongol Empire kept in the Vatican Secret Archives will be delivered to the people of Mongolia. The letters are of great importance in enriching national historical documents and historical research as well since they haven't been publicly disclosed or subject to any research.

The parties agreed to further cooperate on discovering other documents related to the history of Mongolia in the Vatican Secret Archives.

The Cultural and Arts Department, an implementing agency of the Government of Mongolia in collaboration with the National Library has organized a scholarly theoretical and practical conference called “The Present State of the Cultural Documentary Heritage of Background Made of Cloth” on 6 May in anticipation of the “National Writing Day” celebrated within the framework of the implementation of the national programme of safeguarding documentary cultural heritage and UNESCO’s Memory of the World Programme. The objective

of the conference was to share the opinions and experience of specialists and experts in studying and safeguarding the types of the formation of documentary cultural heritage, their evolution, preservation and protection.

A total of 9 papers were presented at the conference, dealing with the unique and traditional method of maintaining and recording Mongolian family tree genealogy, written monuments with cloth covers, paintings on cloths which are preserved at the National Library of Mongolia.

UPCOMING EVENTS

The final program of our Workshop **“Eurasian Parliamentary Practices and Political Mythologies,”** to take place in Heidelberg on **June 17–18, 2019**, is now online.

The keynotes by Prof. John Hsieh (Institutional Change in an Emerging Democracy: The Case of the Legislative Yuan in Taiwan) and Prof. Christopher Atwood (Assembly and Autocracy: Mongolia’s Consultative Polity from Empire to Post-Colonial Modernity) will take place at 16:45–18:15 on June 17 and at 11:45–13:15 on June 18 respectively.

The Workshop will focus on the historical and “reestablished” institutions of collective decision making on the territories of the former Russian, Qing, and Ottoman Empires, as well as adjacent regions of Eastern Europe, Inner and East Asia, and explore parliamentary practices and political mythologies in these parts of Eurasia. The organizers seek to stimulate the dialogue between historians, political scientists, anthropologists, and other scholars working on the named contexts, as well as to breach the divide between different area studies. The goal of the workshop is to present well-researched historical studies of institutions of collective and deliberative decision making in indigenous, imperial, and post-imperial contexts and outline the use of the concepts, stemming from the practices of these institutions, and the appeals to historical practices in modern and contemporary political mythologies. The workshop will contribute to the history of concepts and the study of contemporary political mythologies and practices in both theoretical and empirical terms by bringing the material in a variety of non-European languages into the international academic discussion and tracing the exchange in practices and ideas across Eurasia.
