



PAGE FOUR BUE 105-1348 S E C R E T FROM THE FOREGOING INFORMATION, IT IS APPARENT THAT CORU HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH CEJAS' AND GALANENA'S ABDUCTION AND EXECUTION. OBVIOUSLY, CORU HOPED TO CAPITALIZE UPON THE ABDUCTION OF CEJAS AND GALANENA AND PROBABLY GAMBLED THAT THEIR BODIES WOULD EVENTUALLY TURN UP IN BUENOS AIRES, WHICH WOULD ENABLE CORU TO CLAIM CREDIT FOR THE EXECUTION. HOWEVER, ACCORING TO INFORMATION PROVIDED BY COL. VALIN, CEJAS' AND GALANENA'S BODIES WERE DISPOSED OF IN SUCH A MANNER TO PRECLUDE THEIR EVER BEING FOUND.
