DISCOVERY OF EXTREMIST ARES PACTORY

On 4/7/75, an official of the Buence Alres Provincial Police (BAPP) provided the following information:

Daring the morning of 4/7/73, the RAPP, in a joint operation with officials of the State Secretariat for information (SIDE), raided an extremist arms factory and assembly location in San Justo, Suchos Aires Province. In

the raid components of 30 9 ms. machine guns were saized. Certain components seized were obviously inbricated in other locations; however, various other parts of the machine goes originated at the San Justo factory and accembly point. In addition, plans for a hand-operated bazocka were discovered among the technical material at the location. Specifications for the bancoka indicated it would be approximately 3% feet long and held with a pistol grip. The projectile for the bascoba was to be fired electrically, utilizing four large lanters batteries.

A married couple and another male individual were picked up at the factory and assembly site. These creatants all admirted of being ared for the Elementers enderrille organisation. Information inedice to the raid was secured from interrogations of various Tupameros captured during the preceding week. Three of these Tupamares have aiready been executed by security forces, since they refused to disclose any information.

Paring the morning of 4/7/70, the SAPP invited representatives of the three Argentine armed forces intelligence agencies to view the captured components for the machine gun. Shortly after the arrival of the aread forces representatives. a representative of the Pederal Police of Argentina (PPA). Depart-

ment of Federal Security, appeared and requested that he be allowed to examine the arms factory and assembly point. Acting on orders from Buenos Aires Provincial Governor VICTOR CALABRO, the FPA representative was denied admittance and turned away.

The BAPP intend to maintain information concerning the discovery of the arms factory and assembly location a secret, inasmuch as they are acting on additional information secured through interrogations with prisoners.

The foregoing information should not be discussed with any foreign officials, including those of the Argentine and Uruguayan Governments.
