ON SEPTEMBER 24, 1975, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE ABROAD
REPORTED TERRORISTS PLANTED A POWERFUL BOMB AT THE OFFICES OF
THE XEROX CORPORATION IN CORDOBA, ARGENTINA, DURING THE EARLY
MORNING HOURS OF SEPTEMBER 23, 1975. SOURCE DISCLOSED THAT THE
BOMB CAUSED NO PERSONAL INJURIES AND MODERATE MATERIAL DAMAGE.

SOURCE REPORTED THAT JULIO ANDRES CESAR, AN OFFICIAL
OF THE TRANSAX COMPANY, A SUBSIDIARY OF THE FORD MOTOR COMPANY
IN CORDOBA, WHO HAD BEEN KIDNAPPED BY TERRORISTS ON SEPTEMBER
12, 1975, WAS RELEASED UNHARMED IN CORDOBA DURING THE
MORNING OF SEPTEMBER 23, 1975.
