FOREIGN POLITICAL MATTERS - ARGENTINA

On 2/9/76, the Deputy to General RIVEROS, Commander of the Argentine Army Military Institute's Command at Campo de Mayo, advised that the Argentine Army had definitely resolved that a coup to remove Argentine President PERON is necessary and inevitable and that the Argentine Army is only waiting for the opportune moment to launch the coup, which will be coordinated with the Argentine Navy and Air Force. Source noted that General RIVEROS recently commented that senior Argentine Army Generals feel that the disastrous conditions in Argentina and the Government's inability to cope with these problems, leave the Argentine armed forces with no alternative but to stage a coup. Source advised that General RIVEROS stated that senior Argentine Army Generals believe that a coup would not be opposed by the vast majority of the Argentine people, and that a growing number of them would welcome armed forces intervention in order to end inaction and bungling of the incumbent civilian government.

The source, who is a Lieutenant Colonel, advised that to his knowledge no definite time frame had yet been established for the coup, but expressed his personal opinion that it could occur at any time during the next two weeks, depending on the progression of events throughout the country.
