ON MARCH 23 AND 24, 1976, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE ABROAD, WHO IS AN ARGENTINE ARMY COLONEL, CONNECTED WITH THE MILITARY ARMS FACTORY, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS: (S) (U)

DURING THE EVENING OF MARCH 23, 1976, THE ARGENTINE ARMED FORCES MOVED TO END THE ^{CORRUPT AND FLOUNDERING} GOVERNMENT OF MARIA ESTELA MARTINEZ DE PERON. THROUGHOUT THE EVENING OF MARCH 23RD and THE MORNING OF MARCH 24, 1976, ARGENTINE MILITARY UNITS MOVED INTO PREARRANGED POSITIONS AND TOOK OVER ^{EFFECTIVE} EXECUTIVE CONTROL OF THE ENTIRE COUNTRY. ^{VIRTUALLY NO} ~~VERY LITTLE~~ RESISTANCE TO THE ARMED FORCES' MOVE WAS ENCOUNTERED AND VIOLENCE WAS HELD TO AN ABSOLUTE MINIMUM. ON MARCH 23 AND MARCH 24, 1976, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE ABROAD, WHO IS A RANKING OFFICIAL OF THE ARGENTINE ARMY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: (S) (U)

CARRIED OUT THE INTERVENTION WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF RESISTANCE
AND ARE IN EFFECTIVE CONTROL OF THE ENTIRE COUNTRY.~~COMPLETE~~

NUMEROUS INDIVIDUALS WANTED FOR ECONOMIC CRIMES AND MALFEASANCE OF OFFICE HAVE BEEN PICKED UP BY THE ARGENTINE ARMED FORCES. HOWEVER, TWO OF THE MOST SOUGHT INDIVIDUALS MANAGED TO ESCAPE DURING THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF MARCH 24, 1976. THESE INDIVIDUALS ARE LORENZO MIGUEL, LEADER OF THE 62 ORGANIZATIONS, A POWERFUL LABOR CONFEDERATION, AND FORMER PRESIDENT HECTOR J. CAMPORA. PRESIDENT MARIA ESTELA MARTINEZ DE PERON HAS BEEN TAKEN TO AN ARGENTINE MILITARY INSTALLATION NEAR ~~NEUQUEN~~ ^{IN SOUTHERN ARGENTINA,} WHERE SHE IS BEING HELD UNDER CLOSE GUARD. WHEN ARGENTINE MILITARY PERSONNEL DETAINED MRS. PERON, SHE DREW A PISTOL FROM HER PERSON; HOWEVER, SHE WAS QUICKLY DISARMED BEFORE SHE COULD BET THE WEAPON TO USE. (S) (U)

On 3/24/76, an official of the Argentine Army Intelligence Service provided the following information: (S) (U)

The military intervention against the Peronist Government was effectively carried out without serious opposition during the evening of 3/23/76 and the morning of 3/24/76. Numerous individuals wanted for economic crimes and malfeasance of office by the military have been picked up and are being transferred to military installations throughout the country. Two of the individuals who had been urgently sought somehow managed to escape during the morning of 3/24/76. These individuals are Lorenzo Miguel of the 62 Organizations and former President Hector J. Campora. (S) (U)

FOREIGN POLITICAL MATTERS-ARGENTINA

On 3/24/76, an official of the Argentine Army Intelligence Service (SIE) advised as follows: (S) (U)

Argentine Army personnel went to the residence of retired Argentine Army Major Alberdi, who is also known as "Barbosa", during the evening of 3/23/76 to arrest him in connection with the military intervention. Alberdi had been identified by the SIE as a collaborator with the ERP. Before Army personnel could take custody of Alberdi, he committed suicide. (S) (U)

INTELLIGENCE RECENTLY ACQUIRED BY THE AAIS ESTABLISHED
THAT MARIO ROBERTO SANTUCHO, THE LEADER OF THE ARGENTINE
GUERRILLA ORGANIZATION, THE PEOPLE'S REVOLUTIONARY ARMY (ERP),
RECENTLY FORWARDED A MESSAGE TO CUBAN PREMIER FIDEL CASTRO
REQUESTING THAT 2,500 CUBAN TROOPS BE SENT TO ARGENTINA TO ASSIST
THE ERP IN CARRYING OUT GUERRILLA ACTIVITIES THAT WOULD
EVENTUALLY LEAD TO THE DOWNFALL OF THE ARGENTINE GOVERNMENT.
