1. Laminate the LAPD resource guide and distribute to UPS so that every ambassador has this guide on them at every shift. As I've stated before, we should always give and document our referrals.
2. Obtain and post a LAPD division map on our website. Ideally, it would be great to overlay the LAPD map on our BID map. Once we have the division map, I can ask my friend Mehmet to complete that so it can go on the website.
3. Joseph suggested creating a resource guide list based on priority. Joseph, I would like for you to elaborate or present us with the list and we can research the numbers and populate your list. Will that work?

Status of other topics discussed:

- Flood lights for Security vehicle — John Irigoyen is researching sources and pricing and will get back to me.
- I sent CCTV location map to LAPD SLO, Julie Nony to pull stats related to those locations.
- City Clerk representative, Rick Scott states — “there is no precedent for capping service calls”. He suggested doing what we had planned to do, hold a meeting with the business and our city partners to discuss the ongoing issues. I was confident that we cannot limit calls. Also, Walgreens is located on 2 streets that pay for premium service.
- We need to insure that any and all communications encourage all property and business owners to download and utilize the FREE city app MYLA311.
