March 17 is going to be a special day in Echo Park and the 13th District.

I am thrilled to announce that after years of work, we will finally dedicate a new Senior Center at the Sandra Cisneros Learning Academy on Mohawk Street and Sunset Boulevard.

This senior center has been a long journey, and this specific accomplishment comes full circle in my career as a public servant.

10 years ago, when I was on the staff of my predecessor in the 13th District, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) was gearing up to build a school on Mohawk Street. The site became highly controversial and despite considerable community opposition, a school was built at the location and eventually became what is now the Sandra Cisneros Learning Academy.

After lengthy negotiations with LAUSD that resulted in community benefits, the City received a commitment for a community center, complete with a full size cook's kitchen. As soon as I took office, I resurrected my previous efforts and identified funding to establish a fully operational senior center. The center will offer health resources, art classes, and provide transportation to those in need.

The Echo Park community has long awaited a senior center, and we have some wonderful partners in this collaboration. I would like to thank Laura Trejo and Marco Perez with the Department of Aging, as well as St Barnabas Senior Center, and LAUSD school board members Ref Rodriguez and Bennett Keyser (retired).

I am so thrilled to offer this wonderful new amenity to the community. As the years go by, our aging community deserves to have a dependable and robust network of supportive services, which includes top-notch senior centers across the City.


