Just got back after 2 hours of Elemental fun.

The Honda would not start due to a starter problem.

I used my AAA card to have it towed to Friendly Auto (323) 461-3415.

1. Unfortunately, this is an expensive starter in a difficult location for service.

Intake manifold and throttle assy. etc. will have to removed.

Rough estimate: \$465 w/labor + tax on parts.

2. Additionally related is a transmission switch which will often not let the vehicle start in park.

With a good starter motor, it will start in neutral but since this is not advisable due to the possibility of the vehicle rolling (as well as being annoying),

I told Vrezh, the mechanic, to perform this repair.

Parts and labor = \$175.

Repairs will be completed Monday by end of day.
