


## Ready for Takeoff at LAX?



Looking to track real-time noise levels at LAX -- along with airplane emissions, flight delays, traffic and airport spending? Well, now you can -- thanks to an online dashboard that my office released this week in conjunction with the Industrial, Economic and Administrative Survey (IEA) of L.A. World Airports (LAWA).

## Read "This Map of LAX Plane Noise is Weirdly Mesmerizing" on CurbedLA



Among the features you'll find:

- A real-time noise map of the area surrounding LAX where users can track the decibel levels of planes that have taken off and landed.
- LAWA's checkbook, which shows how much the airports spent in FY 2014-15 on goods and services ranging from luggage carts (\$3.9 million) to fingerprint processing (\$314,425) to dog food (\$11,296--for the police K-9 unit.)
- Greenhouse gas emissions data broken down by vehicle type and source. (Airport buses, which run on natural gas, emit comparatively few greenhouse gases.)
- Graphics showing the value of the goods and services
