This week, my colleagues on the City Council and Lintroduced reforms to help manage the City's growth and development, and protect the unique character of our neighborhoods. Our motion instructed the Planning Department to report back on updating all 35 Community Plans. They also called for recommendations on ways to increase oversight of the environmental review process and upgrade outdated technology. Angelenos deserve a transparent and fair process when evaluating impacts on their residential neighborhoods and to ensure that the city can effectively deliver on its land-use responsibilities. Although more must be done, this is a step in the right direction to rebuilding trust in the City's planning process.
