Dan and Oscar:

Thanks again for yesterday. I think we made "some" progress with regard to the idea od shared parking and Television Center.

But, as you could see, its wasn't "this sounds great, how we can help" type response. It was "we're conservative and have obligations to our tenants first...."

This is totally understood, but I also think Ana was focused on the day time needs. AND, I went out to Pasadena and back and got back around early afternoon – MID-DAY – and drove the entire garage. There were BARELY 11 cars parked above Level 4. There was ONE car at level 6 on the roof. Level 5 had about 4 or 5 cars. Almost all the cars wer either exterior or on Levels 2 or 3.

So, there is NO WAY that they wouldn't be able to afford up to 100 spots on Thursday to Sunday evenings. I do understand, and can appreciate, the issue of cost and what it costs them in terms of security, etc, but there is NO onsite security at the garage anyway. Its all monitored through cameras and by the security person at the Cahuenga Avenue access gate.

It seems to be me the Council Office developing a letter and highlighting the community benefit/need and overall economic development importance of the topic of shared parking solutions should be paramount. AND, this may be beyond this discussion here, but if the garage is making NO money at night because all the Golds parkers get 3 hour validation, why would it be a problem them to not offer the theaters the same options (perhaps 4 hour validation) and/or maybe there's some tax benefit that can be offered to the garage owners if they offered discounted rates.

It would be helpful if the BID can gather data to include:

- How many theaters are we talking about;
- How many seats are we talking about;
- How many nights of activity are there overall

We will have to present some relevant data that Ana can take to her owners to present this idea and advocate for us.

Finally, one of our Econ Dev Comm attendees the other day also pointed out a lot owned by some agency of city government that is nearby. This may represent another option if TV Center takes too long in getting back to us.

But, to say the least, if the main parking structure has 2 + levels pretty much empty in the middle of the day on a Thursday, then I would suspect there's not a lot of there there on the evenings we're requesting.
